Why does my RV smell like rotten eggs?

Ever had this problem in your RV? You should never ignore any kind of weird smell in your Airstream. They don't normally go away on their own and in most

cases they get worse with time. So why might your Airstream smell like rotten eggs, you may ask? Here are a few things that require your attention...

As you all know, your water heater, furnace and refrigerator can be operated off of your propane gas tank. Propane is typically an odorless gas, but the gas companies add a rotten egg smell to the gas so that it will bring attention to you if you would ever have a gas LEAK!!

Another cause of the rotten egg smell can be bacteria growth in your fresh water tank. It can also occur in your water heater tank. A chemical reaction creates sulfide gas and this can cause your water to have the dreaded rotten egg smell. Guess what? It's time to sanitize your freshwater system to get rid of the smell.

Your batteries can also create a terrible smell. If your batteries give off a rotten egg smell the chances are they are likely too dry or they have been overcharged. Best case scenario is you need to add water. Worst case is you have to replace your batteries.

Last but not least on the list is the dreaded black water tank. Black water tank build up can also be a source of the rotten egg smell. Bacteria can build up and the smell can enter your Airstream. Can you say flush your tank, flush your tank? A good flush and an enzyme treatment should ensure the smell goes away and does not return.

Campfire Pizza Nachos

Garlic Cream Sauce Ingredients:

- Unsalted Butter
- •Olive Oil
- Garlic Cloves
- •Heavy Cream
- •Milk
- Parmesan Cheese
- Salt
- Pepper
- Red Pepper Flakes

Directions for Garlic Cream Sauce:

Melt the butter and olive oil in a saucepan. Once the butter is melted, add the minced

garlic. Stir. After a minute or two, add in the cream and milk. Stir until it comes to a boil. Add salt, pepper, red pepper flakes, and cheese. Stir until sauce has thickened. Once it has thickened, remove from fire and set aside.

Directions for Nachos:

Grab your <u>cast iron skillet</u> and add the tortilla chips. Drizzle the garlic cream sauce all over the chips. Top with the onions, pepperoni, olives, bell pepper, and Colby-jack cheese. The best approach is to layer your toppings between tortilla chips so every bite gets plenty of goodies. Place over the open fire and cover. Cook until the cheese is nice and bubbly and the veggies are warm, about 5-8 minutes.

Crock Pot Chicken

Ingredients:

- 4 skinless chicken breasts
- 1 ounce dry ranch salad dressing and seasoning mix
- 1 (10.5 ounce) can of condensed cream chicken soup
- 1 cup water or chicken broth

Instructions:

- Grease the slow cooker with non-stick spray.
- Place the chicken into the bottom of the Crock Pot.
- Top with the chicken soup.
- Sprinkle the ranch seasoning on top and pour the water over the seasoning.
- Replace the lid and cook on low for seven hours.
- Once it is done cooking, shred chicken with a fork, and serve over mashed potatoes.
