



Salsa Recipes By: Kookie Abad and Cindy Rapp



Our February rally featured a salsa contest and there was a call for the winners to share their recipes. Here are the two winning salsas.

Mango Salsa (Kookie Abad)

Mix:

1 large mango, peeled and diced

3/4 cup chopped red bell pepper

1/4 cup fresh chopped cilantro

1/3 cup chopped red onion

1 large avocado, peeled and diced

Juice of ½ to 1 lime, to taste

1 Tbsp olive oil

Salt and Pepper to taste

Finely chopped jalapeno, if desired



Best Homemade Salsa (Cindy Rapp)

- · 4 ripe tomatoes, cored and quartered
- 1 red onion, peeled and quartered
- 3 garlic cloves, peeled
- 3 jalapenos, stemmed and seeded (you can substitute 1-2 habanero or serrano peppers.)
- 1/3 cup fresh cilantro
- 3 tablespoons fresh lime juice
- 2-3 teaspoons ground cumin
- 2-3 teaspoons sugar (optional)
- 1 1/2 teaspoons salt
- 15 ounces crushed San Marzano tomatoes (1 can)
- 4.5 ounces diced green chiles, mild, medium, or hot (1 can)

Instructions

- Place the fresh tomatoes, onion, garlic, peppers, cilantro, lime juice, 2 teaspoons cumin, 2 teaspoons sugar (if using), and salt in a food processor. Pulse until the contents are fine and well blended.
- 2. Pour in the crushed tomatoes and green chiles. Puree until mostly smooth. Taste, then add more cumin and sugar if desired. Refrigerate until ready to serve.


