The BOD is also working on updating the Harbor's business plan so that it can be shared with you all. This will give you a better sense of what the plan looks like for the Harbor and will give you an opportunity to ask questions. The BOD has also gone to a biweekly meetings schedule to give them more opportunities to meet as a group and make decisions. Meanwhile, if you have any questions about the Harbor or how progress is coming along, the best way to get information directly is to attend the BOD meetings either in person or by Zoom. 
