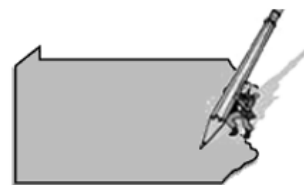

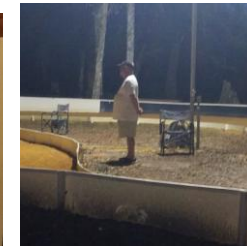


Also in attendance were Toni and Ron Purdum and Marguerite Glaser and Jim Ridolfi. Good food and great fellowship.

1. After paying registration fee, you'll be directed here:



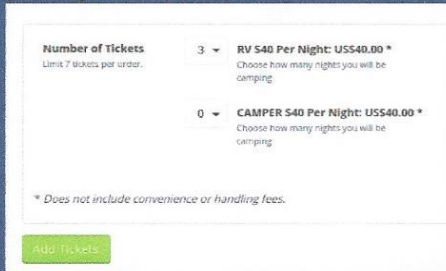
Scroll down to get to the link to book your site ("General Camping - Reserve Your Space"):



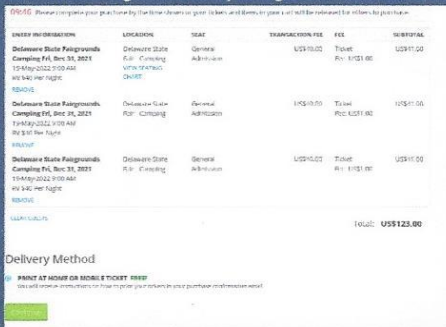
2. Pick the starting date for your reservation on the calendar, then select it in the drop down box:
