Time to Make Reservations

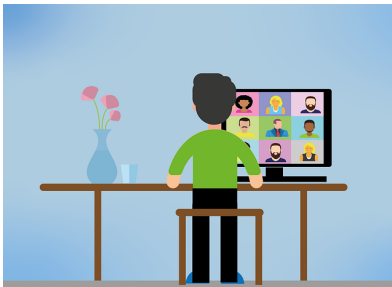

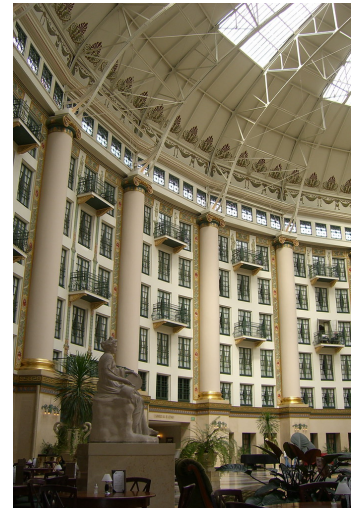
Patoka Lake State Park French Lick, IN

Hi gang.

After many years of owning RVs - including two Airstream trailers - Alice and I wrote *RVs & Campers For Dummies*, published last summer by John Wiley & Sons Publishing. We're proud to report that the book has become remarkably popular in a relatively short time, and has been very positively reviewed. It's available in both paperback and Kindle editions from [Amazon.com](https://www.amazon.com), Barnes & Noble, and Wal-Mart.

Since 2005, my wife (who writes under the name of Alice Von Kannon) and I have written several books in the popular 'For Dummies' series published by Wiley Publishing. My first book, *Freemasons For Dummies* (2005) is in its third edition and is the best-selling introduction to the Masonic fraternity in the U.S. and the U.K. It's even been translated into several foreign languages. Alice also writes historical romance novels: *Heart's Blood* was published in 2020, and she will be releasing two more titles this spring.

We have both been featured in several programs for History, Discovery, NatGeo and the American Heroes Channel on the subjects of Freemasonry, the medieval Knights Templar, secret and secretive societies, and conspiracy theories. I'm scheduled to be interviewed in May for an upcoming episode of *Unexplained* with William Shatner.

We spend a fair amount of summers RVing in our 30' Flying Cloud, and we usually spend six weeks at Christmastime camped in Southern California to see family. When we're not on the road, we live in Indianapolis with our canine companion, Sophie the Flying Poodle.
