Description:

We will be camping at Holiday Park Campground which was at one time an Airstream Only Park. Many sites are still owned by Airstream owners with Airstreams permanently housed there. Come and check out the old Airstream Boneyard!!!

This rally will be mostly unstructured, more of a campout, to give everyone time to explore your own interests. But we are checking on a couple ideas for presenters that could be interesting and fun. We will have morning gatherings for coffee and evening socializing in the pavilion or by a campfire.

Rally Fees:

There is a \$20.00 rally fee, collected at the rally. Your camping fees, paid directly by each attendee to Holiday RV Campground. Any activities, restaurant meals, passes to parks and recreation etc. are paid by attendees. Site fees are \$65 per night | \$6 reservation fee | 30/50amp | full hook-up.




