ON THE LEVEL

Hi everyone, I wanted to let you know about a device we use that makes set up of our trailer a little easier when we arrive at our camp site. It is the LevelMatePRO. The LevelMatePRO is a wireless vehicle leveling system that accurately reports how much height is required to reach a level position and tells you where that height is needed (side to side and front to back)

It wirelessly connects with your smartphone or tablet, where an easy-to-use app displays the needed leveling information. Before entering your site, turn on the device in your rig and use the app to connect to the device via bluetooth. As you pull into your site, the app will display accurate information about how level the site is. You can monitor leveling data as you pull into a site, allowing you to pick the most level spot before you park, which is a huge help for us. Additionally, it can save your hitch position when you disconnect your trailer from your tow vehicle which really helps when you are ready to hitch back up.

This is what I really like about the LevelMatePro:

- Drastically reduces setup time
- Easy to install and simple to use
- Accurate to 1/4 inch
- Enables real time site evaluation before you park
- Compatible with most smartphones and tablets
- Wireless connection is automatic and quick

Installation of the LevelMatePro was easy. First, you have to make sure the LevelMatePro knows what level is. To do that I used a 2 foot bubble level (any size will work) to ensure the trailer was level front to back and side to side. Then I selected a location to mount the LevelMatePro unit transmitter, towards the front of the trailer, to ensure proper connection with our smart device when inside our tow vehicle.

When you mount the transmitter, the top cover should face the front, side or rear of the trailer with the arrows on the label facing up. Once the transmitter is

mounted turn on the transmitter and follow the App's prompts to complete set up. As an FYI, the model we have has a battery so I would highly recommend you mount the transmitter for easy access to turn it on, off and to change the battery.

There are two models available: LevelMatePro and the new LevelMatePro+. The latter includes a US port to power the unit if you prefer not to use batteries. It also has a little bit more of an updated app that will work on an Apple Watch. Hope you all find this to be as useful of a tool as we do!
