

Newsletter Editor Ramblings

Hard to work on the Airstream in the middle of Winter, so we are working on one of my "After Retirement" projects - the stairs. Replacing all of the treads, risers, and handrails going from the 1st floor to the 2nd floor. Like so many projects, this is taking longer than expected and costing more than expected. So, basically a normal project for us...

The two pictures below show our current progress.





The new treads, risers, and wall attached handrail are all in place. Plus, the two newel posts I built, which is the real reason for sharing. The treads, handrails, and newel posts are all red oak stained with Provincial stain and varnished. Currently working on building the handrails that will attach to the newel posts as well as the landing floor and rest of the trim, which will also all be stained red oak. Hopefully I will have it all finished before the new newsletter!

On a warmer day last week, Kay and I went out and sat in the Airstream and talked about this coming camping season and projects we want to do. The big one is replacing or covering the curved front headliner. The current headliner is a PVC one we installed 12 - 13 years ago while we were remodeling the entire trailer. Last year, we discovered that it has developed a couple of cracks. Last Fall, we read in *Airstream Life* magazine that Colin Hyde Trailer Restorations sells Airstream Headliner kits. These are preformed (curved) and pre-drilled pie shaped sheets of aluminum, that all you have to do is rivet them together and then install. Sounds simple enough, right? S Anyway, we will see exactly how easy it is once the weather warms up some. The kit is seven pieces of aluminum with many, many holes for the rivets (about every inch around the perimeter of each piece. In preparation, I bought another 50 Clecos (Google "cleco fasteners") giving us 75 total, and a few hundred rivets. I will include pictures of that project in a future Newsletter.

Quick update - took a break from the newsletter and got started on the landing.
