It's time to make reservations for our second Weekender Rally – June 12 – 14 at Oubache State Park in Bluffton. There are lots of things to see & do around the park and in Bluffton – buffalo grazing, geocaches, hiking, and biking on the River Greenway to Bluffton. Nearby is the village of Berne with the Swiss Heritage Village & Museum, the Muensterberg Plaza and Clock Tower. and Swiss shops. A little further away in Geneva is Limberlost, Gene Stratton Porter's home. You can also walk through part of the restored Loblolly Marsh or take a walking tour of historic Geneva.

Each member should call to reserve a campsite. Reservations may be made starting six months in advance - THAT IS DECEMBER 12. If you must cancel later, there is a \$10 fee for a cancellation made 8 or more days in advance. Because we always try to fill a cancelled spot with another club member, your risk of a fee may be low or nil. Let's try to fill up sites 26-40 first, then any other spot available on the loop.
