# June 2021 - Clifty Falls State Park

On December 15<sup>th</sup>, we emailed to all club members details on our June 2021 Clifty Falls State Park outing. We are resharing that information below.

Dear Central Indiana Airstream Friends,

I hope that this email finds you all well.

I am writing to provide some information on the June 2021 Camping Event for our club that we are planning.

As the club executive committee put together a calendar of events for 2021, which we will get published in an edition of the Ticker to come out shortly, we discussed planning an event for the month of June that would be a bit longer than our typical Friday-Sunday weekender.

Here is what we are planning. We will hold a "camping event" - I guess we should call it a rally - at Clifty Falls State Park in Madison, Indiana. The dates will be Thursday, June 10 through Sunday, June 13. Your hosts will be Joe and Julie Ashland (one thing we are starting this year is having "hosts" for each event).

Consider this a "flexible arrival date" event.....we understand that some people will not be able to be there for the entire event.....come and stay as much as your schedule permits.

Your hosts will be arranging one or perhaps two activities for Thursday (June 10), Friday (June 11), and Saturday (June 12). We are thinking of including a visit to the Lanier Mansion/Madison Visitor Center Museum and a historic walking tour of the town and/or a riding tour (the visitor center offers guides for these sort of things). # Minutes of Executive Board Meeting

# Central Indiana Airstream Club

# September 10, 2020

President John Deegan presiding.

E-meeting called to order at 7:00 PM EST. Board members present, Pres. John Deegan, 1<sup>st</sup> VP Joe Ashland, Treasurer Mary Ellen Deegan, Secretary Charles Mason, Trustees Daryl and Denise Baldwin, Trustee Mike Brown.

A quorum is present.

Joe Ashland moved to accept the meeting minutes from May 12, 2020 and June 11,2020 as written. Daryl Baldwin 2<sup>nd</sup>. Vote was unanimous: Yes.

Mary Ellen Deegan read the Treasurers' report and will Email the report to the Secretary to be included in the current meeting minutes. She recommends the Club should spend some of the money instead of setting the membership annual dues at \$0.00. Joe Ashland agreed and feels the Club could use money in recruitment of new members. Daryl Baldwin moved that the annual dues be restored to \$15.00 beginning January 1, 2021. Mike Brown 2<sup>nd</sup>. Vote was unanimous: Yes.

Mary Ellen Deegan reported that CIAC has 46 Regular members and 3 Affiliate members. She said the "membership portal" on the International website is not ready for membership renewal.

Chris Dillow sent out the current Directory with the revised Constitution and Bylaws (C&B) on September 6, 2020. The C&B changes will need to be voted on by the membership.

Pres. Deegan proposed adding the office of 2<sup>nd</sup> VP to the Executive Board. He also proposed that the number of Trustees be increased. Joe Ashland suggested to add 2 trustees now and maybe more later. Daryl Baldwin suggested a minimum of 4 and a maximum of 8. Joe Ashland moved to have min.4/max.8 trustees. Daryl Baldwin 2<sup>nd</sup>. Vote unanimous: Yes. This change will need a vote by the membership. Chris Dillow will make changes to C&B for inclusion in the Sept. "Ticker". Joe Ashland to send out Sept. "Ticker" before October 1<sup>st</sup>.

The October CIAC Weekender is still on the schedule. The attendees will need to practice safe distancing and Covid-19 protection. Info will be included in the "Ticker".

Joe Ashland reviewed the proposed CIAC calendar for years 2021 and 2022. He suggested to have a program/speaker at CIAC luncheons and to not have luncheons in January and March. He cited low attendance at luncheons during winter months. Daryl Baldwin said that even small attendance allowed positive interactions. Since CIAC does not plan camping events in the same month as the International and Region 5 Rallies, he suggested having "no host" weekend camping for those members who can't/do not attend the International or Region 5 Rallies.

Pres. Deegan asked the Board for names of members for possible future office holders. Joe Ashland will make an appeal in the "Ticker" for member involvement in the Club.

Pres. Deegan said Brenda Ansel asked if CIAC might organize a caravan to the International Rally in Tennessee next year. He said it is about a 6-hour drive. He will contact Brenda to see if she would be willing to be the organizer.

Pres. Deegan stated that Tom and Vickie Ketcham (affiliate members) are planning a National Caravan from Baltimore, Md to Vandalia, Illinois. The caravan would be during May of 2022 and would consist of (3) nine-day segments. Ketchams have asked if anyone from CIAC would like to "co-host" the rally with them.

Pres. Deegan asked the Board members to think about ways to recruit new members and encourage member involvement. He would like to have 5-6 more members. The Club would like members to volunteer for jobs like: "Ticker" editor, Hospitality, Historian and others.

Pres. Deegan proposed awarding Lifetime CIAC Membership to Barry and Karen Bell. Mike Brown moved to do so. Daryl Baldwin 2<sup>nd</sup>. Vote was unanimous: Yes.

Pres. Deegan stated that the CIAC used to host the INDY 500 National Rally. Camping was at the State Fairgrounds. Daryl Baldwin and Pres. Deegan will check with Barry Bell to get info of what would be involved to host a National Rally. If a multi-day rally is too involved, then maybe a rally on race weekend might work out.

Damon Beals reported about the International website. The home office has moved to a new platform. All the Club websites will be on the International site and will have the same "look" and format.

Open discussion: Need to find ways to encourage member involvement. Pres. Deegan and Damon Beals will send letters/emails to all members to "Welcome" and promote the CIAC activities to generate interest.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:53 PM.

# Wildflower Foray Rally WBCCI Illinois Lincolnland Airstream Club #176 of WBAC

Bernie and Mary Taylor are hosting the Wildflower Foray Rally in beautiful Brown County Indiana State Park, next April 23-26, 2021. Because the Wildflower Foray activities begin on Friday, April 23, 2021, you may wish to arrive on Thursday, April 22, 2021. We will be camping in the Buffalo Ridge Campground, electric sites 32-52. Please see the attached campground map, with Public Policies and Procedures. Park website is https://www.in.gov/dnr/parklake/2988.htm.

Brown County Indiana State Park is a very popular park, especially in the Spring and Fall. Because of its popularity, early camp site reservations are absolutely necessary for this rally. By early, we mean your reservations <u>must</u> be made now. Otherwise, camp sites will not be available, as Mary and I learned in April 2019. Some sites in this loop are already reserved. Buffalo Ridge Campground Class A electric only sites 32-52 are \$24.61 (includes tax) per night, Sunday-Wednesday; and \$32.10 (includes tax) per night, Thursday-Saturday. You may call or go online to make your reservations. When making your reservations, you will be charged for your entire stay plus a \$5.00 nonrefundable registration fee. The park entrance fee is \$9.00 for outof-state vehicles and is a one-time fee during your stay. Water is available so be sure to bring your water hoses. There is also a dump station. Because this rally is the end of April, and the weather can be unpredictable, we have reserved an enclosed building for our use for Friday, Saturday, and Sunday. The \$135.00 reservation fee for the building will be prorated among those attending the rally.

To make reservations for camp sites through Reserve America, go online <u>www.CAMP.IN.gov</u> or call 1-866-622-6746. Call Center hours are: Monday-Friday 12:00 Noon – 8:00 P.M. and Saturday-Sunday 12:00 Noon – 5:00 P.M., EDT (Indiana is 1 hour ahead of us).

The cancellation policy/fee is:

- 1. 8 or more days prior to arrival \$10.00 cancellation fee
- 2. 1-7 days prior to arrival 1<sup>st</sup> night camping fee + tax
- 3. if day of arrival or later NO refund-you forfeit your entire amount paid

## There are NO refunds due to inclement weather.

# <u>VERY IMPORTANT</u>: You must use the West Gate Entrance to enter the park with your RV, 1405 S. R. 46 W., Nashville, IN 47448

The Wildflower Foray is hosted by the T. C. Steele State Historic Site. The hikes and programs encompass a wide area.
