Recipe of the Month – A New Feature!

Ever have great potatoes? Try these.

They're "Grater!"

Grater Potato Casserole (Serves 12)

- 6 -7 medium potatoes
- 1/2 cup margarine or 1/2 cup butter, melted
- 1 1/2 cups cheddar cheese, grated
- 1/2 cup white onion, grated
- 1 cup sour cream
- 1 (10-3/4 ounce) can cream of chicken soup
- salt and pepper to taste

Boil whole potatoes for 15 minutes.

Cool, then peel and grate into a large bowl.

(It's easy to grate the onion while the potatoes boil).

Add remaining ingredients to potato/onion mixture and mix well. Place in greased 9x13 baking dish and cover. Refrigerate overnight. Bake uncovered 350° 45-60 minutes. It should be brown and bubbly. Good dish for a "Pitch-In" or "Pot Luck!"

There are lots of things to see & do around the park and in Bluffton – buffalo grazing, geocaches, hiking, and biking on the River Greenway to Bluffton. Nearby is the village of Berne with the Swiss Heritage Village & Museum, the Muensterberg Plaza and Clock Tower. and Swiss shops. A little further away in Geneva is Limberlost, Gene Stratton Porter's home. You can also walk through part of the restored Loblolly Marsh or take a walking tour of historic Geneva.
