### THOUGHTS FROM OUR PRESIDENT

Greetings CIACers,

Finally, summer is here. And we had a glorious 4<sup>th</sup> of July weekend. Mary Ellen and I do hope you enjoyed the holiday weekend, hopefully with family and friends, maybe even out in the glorious weather enjoying your Airstream.

This month – July – is the start of a whirlwind summer for the CIAC, with something for everyone including the International Rally at Lebanon, TN, a weekender at Turkey Run State Park, our Club Picnic, The Region Five Rally in Warsaw, IN, the Swiss Festival National Rally in Ohio, and our Season Close

Weekender at Versailles State Park. Also, Alumapalooza at the Airstream Factory just before the Region Five Rally. That is a lot of Airstreaming, but that is why our Airstreams have wheels – to go to these events and more!

As of a few days ago, the CIAC had 31 Regular and Affiliate members signed up for the International Rally (that is 16 rigs). Several members of this group plan to overnight at the Cedars of Lebanon State Park in Lebanon, TN, prior to the start of the International Rally. This should allow us to enter the Rally together and camp together. If you are interested in joining us on our journey into the International Rally site, but are not camping with us, please plan to be at the State Park on Thursday morning, July 15<sup>th</sup>, before 11 AM local time, ready to roll out with the CIAC group. IMPORTANT: Please let me know if you plan to roll with us to the Rally. We do plan to have a Pitch-In dinner on Wednesday night; please let Brenda Ansel know if you plan to join us at the Pitch-In.

For those going to the International Rally, there is an APP called Grupio available for smart phones and tablets. This APP will provide access to schedules, maps, exhibitors, attendees and much more. I have it on my iPhone and it is pretty interesting!

At the end of the month, CIAC will be hosting a Weekender at Turkey Run State Park. Weekender dates: July 30-August 1, 2021. This will be a Grandchildren/Children Weekender. Bring your Grandchildren or Children because there are lots to do in and around Turkey Run State Park. Biking, hiking

trails, a huge pool, canoeing and kayaking are some of the activities for you, your grandchildren or your children. And it is ok to bring their parents too! By the way, I do not recommend you follow your GPS to get to Turkey Run. Mary Ellen and I tried that, and it was a very circuitous route. Our GPS wanted to take us on several gravel and dirt roads while we could have simply taken this route: Follow US 36 West to US 41 just west of Rockville. Then turn north on US 41 (right turn). Go about 6 miles and turn east (right) on Indiana 47. The State Park is just a couple of miles down the road on the left. Turn in at the "camping" sign.

In closing, I would like to remind everyone that the Club will be hosting a catered Summer Picnic at the Fort Benjamin Harrison State Park in Indianapolis on Saturday, August 21, 2021. This is not a camping activity, but an afternoon of fellowship and fun. I have recently learned there will be an outdoor summer concert with the GMH Jazz Orchestra performing on Sledding Hill right next to the Sycamore Shelter (which we have reserved) on Saturday evening from 7 PM to 8 PM. ## **WBCCI Lifetime Membership Increase**


Any CIAC member contemplating becoming a WBCCI Lifetime Member should consider doing so prior to August 1, 2021.

On that date, there will be an increase in the cost of becoming a Lifetime Member. The one-time cost of Lifetime Membership will increase between 25% and 92%, depending upon the blended age of club members. Blended age is defined as the average age of applicant(s) rounded up. In other words, if the two club members applying for Lifetime Membership are ages 60 and 55, then their blended age is 58.

Using the example of a couple with a blended age of 58, they will pay \$1,350 until August 1, 2021, to become Lifetime Members. After August 1, 2021, they will pay \$1,800 (a 33% increase).

Lifetime members are still required to pay local club or member-at-large annual dues.





















# BEN SCHROEDER SADDLE TREE CO. MADISON, INDIANA

## AMERICA'S LAST SADDLETREE FACTORY

America's last 19th century saddletree factory stands suspended-in-time in Madison, Indiana. Here for 94 years, workers at the Ben Schroeder Saddle Tree Company crafted tens of thousands of "wooden skeletons" for saddle makers in the Unites States. South America and Cuba.

As cars, trucks and tractors started putting horses out to pasture, the Schroeder family began making stirrups, hame pack saddle frames and eart trees, natural extensions of the saddletree trade, Non-telated tiems produced, such a clothespins, porch swings and work gloves, illustrate the

The factory, closed in 1972, remains intact with sawins pheuunder rare and unique wintage woodworking machinery. When restored, the Schroeder complex will re-open as a museum, the only one in the nation preserving the eraft of the saddletree maker.
