

Recipe of the Month

Bok Choy Salad

(Stovetop)

Mix, boil, and refrigerate, covered:

Best flavor if dressing made a day ahead!

4 cup Lite Soy Sauce

2 c sugar or Splenda (or choice sugar substitute)

4 c white vinegar

1 stick butter
2 packages Ramen Chicken Flavor Noodles crushed
 Dry seasoning packets from the noodles
3 green onions, diced with tops
 3 ounces sunflower kernels
1 bunch Bok Choy (white parts only --- diced)
 4 ounces sliced almonds

2 heads iceberg lettuce

Melt butter in large skillet. Crush noodles, add flavoring packets, and brown in the butter. Add sunflower kernels & almonds. Brown a bit. Spread on cookie sheet lined with paper towels and refrigerate. This mixture will self-drain. Ready to serve? Cut or tear lettuce and place in a large bowl. Pour noodle mixture over lettuce and toss. Pour dressing over lettuce mixture and toss well. Does not keep well. Use it up or throw it out!

It's great for a group! (Cut back amounts 50% if not serving at least 6.)
