Mississippi Corn Salad 2 Cans White Shoe-peg Corn— (other kinds won't work) 1 Bunch green onions—chopped fine green part, too. 1 Tomato—seeded and chopped—also fine 1/2 Cup Mayonnaise - May also use 1/4 Cup Mayo and 1/4 Cup Yogurt Mix everything together, and if time allows let set overnight or a few hours—makes it better. A little salt, and a lot of pepper - or to taste It's also nice to put it in a bowl with something green around the edge—Lettuce, parsley, I even used fresh spinach. Makes it look "special".
