## **Parting Note**

**Guy C. Porter, Jr.**, 94, died peacefully at home on Tuesday, November 16, 2021. He was born December 1926 in Charleston and lived his whole life in the house his father built in 1925. He is



survived by his wife and our WVAC member Carmel Barber Porter, many children, grandchildren and great grandchildren. He was a 73-year member of Kanawha Lodge #20 AF&AM. He also was a member of Scottish Rite of Charleston, Tyrian Chapter #13, Commandery #4, Beni Kedem Temple A.A.O.N.M.S., Past President of Beni Kedem Oriental Band, Tiskelwah Chapter #45 Order of the Eastern Star, and Order of the White Shrine of Jerusalem serving as Supreme Second Wise Man.

He enjoyed traveling extensively and was Past President of the West Virginia Unit of the Airstream Club where he was a member for 40 years. He had many Airstream vehicles and attended innumerable rallies in which he would volunteer with enthusiasm. One of his favorite rallies was the Swiss Festival National Rally in Sugarcreek, OH where he and Carmel would become tour guides dressed in Swiss costume. They would take rally folks over hill and hollow while explaining the customs, foods and traditions of the area. He particularly enjoyed traveling to his second home, a log cabin in Sevierville, TN. Fond memories of Guy will be told over our campfires.



On Thursday January 20, our friend and WV Airstream Club member **Donald Wayne Barth** passed away to his eternal home while vacationing in Hawaii. Wayne was visiting his sister and enjoying the Pacific paradise when he took ill and died on Maui Island. Wayne was 77 years old.

He was preceded in death by his wife of 38 years, Carroll.

Working in the transportation industry, Wayne's knack with diesel equipment led him to international service opportunities. He trained crews

in South America and Asia in the operation and maintenance of heavy equipment. He was recognized as a Guild Master Detroit Diesel Mechanic by the National Institute Automotive Service Excellence.

Wayne was a member of the Princeton Elks Lodge and the Princeton Moose Lodge. He was 32<sup>nd</sup> Degree Scottish Rite Mason and a member of the Royal Order of Jesters 111. He served as treasurer of the Bluefield Shrine for a number of years and was a Past-President of South Atlantic Shrine Patrol Association. He worked extensively in the preparation and operation of the Shrine's annual horse show and Oyster Dinner.

Wayne and his late wife Carroll toured America for twenty-five years with like-minded Airstream ralliers. He enjoyed meeting new people, seeing new places, and re-establishing contact with old Airstream friends. His hobbies include camping, hunting, fishing, and golf. Wayne was always ready to share a drink on his patio, a meal from his grill, his opinion on the world and a moment with friends.

Wayne had been a corner stone of our Airstream Club serving multiple tenures as President, Vice President and Director spanning several decades. His willingness to lead set the example for convoying and rally protocol. He is greatly missed.
