Here is a little more info on the Crabby Rally. We will be camping at the Crisfield American Legion located at 116 Lorie Quinn Road, Crisfield, MD. It has water and electric hookups at each of the 12 individual sites. There are showers and a dump station located on the grounds. Campers will be parked along the Chesapeake Bay shoreline with a beautiful view of the Bay to the west. There is a small beach along the shoreline and I've been reliably informed there are no sharks in the adjacent waters. The water is still warm in September so swimming and boating are possible activities for kids and families. Pets are welcome. The price per night for camping is \$40.00 plus there will be a small rally fee. I'm hoping that attendees will want to go as a group to a local crab house to have dinner together on Saturday evening, September 24. I will give more details as the rally draws closer, so keep your eye on our newsletter for updates on the latest info.

On or about June 1, all our members as of that date will receive an email from Wally Byam Caravan Club International (WBCCI) asking them to vote on WBCCI officers for next year (2023). The email will contain a ballot which the member will complete and return directly to WBCCI as instructed in the email.

Also, on or about June 1, each member will receive an email from WBCCI asking them to consider two proposed changes to the WBCCI Constitution. Each MAAC member should return their vote to me at my email address. These votes will be tabulated, certified, and submitted to WBCCI at the WBCCI International Rally in Fryeburg, Maine on July 27, 2022. The submission will be made by the MAAC delegate to the International Rally. If you are planning to attend the International Rally, please let me know if you would be our delegate.

A Member Voting Guide is included elsewhere in this newsletter to give you additional information on these two voting procedures.

I am now accepting nominations and volunteers to be MAAC officers for next year. The positions available include President, First Vice President, Second Vice President, Newsletter Editor, and Webmaster. We may have additional openings for Recording Secretary, Membership Secretary, and Treasurer if the current incumbents do not wish to continue in office.

MEMBER VOTING

ELECTIONS

Two separate elections will occur in 2022—one for the election of **International Officers** and one to vote on the **Constitutional amendments**.

WHO VOTES?

Every member in good standing with the Wally Byam Caravan Club International, Inc. aka Airstream Club International, on June 1 of each year is eligible to vote for **International Officer** and any **Constitutional amendment(s)** presented to the membership.

Memberships = One or two adults

Members = Individual people

Each **member** can cast one vote. One member, one vote.

WHAT IS VOTED ON?

The **International Officers** make up the Executive Committee (EC), who, with the 12 Region Presidents, make up the International Board of Trustees, the governing body of our Club. The EC, with the immediate Past International President, is the administrative branch of our Club.

A **Constitutional amendment** is a change or addition to the Club's Constitution. The Constitution defines what the Wally Byam Caravan Club International, Inc., aka Airstream Club International, is.

WHEN WILL THE VOTE OCCUR?

The election for **International Officers** will take place between June 1 through June 15, 2022.

The vote for the **Constitutional amendments** will be carried out on July 27, 2022, at the Constitutional Delegates Meeting in Fryeburg, Maine.

HOW DOES A MEMBER VOTE?

The election for **International Officers** will be by electronic ballot. HQ will send every eligible member in good standing a ballot to the email address they have on file in the membership database. Paper ballots are available to members upon request beginning May 15, 2022, by contacting HQ at 937-596-5211.

The vote for the **Constitutional amendments** is currently a two-step process. Each Local Club is **REQUIRED** to provide a method to collect the vote of each eligible member. A list of ALL eligible members will be sent to each Club on June 1, 2022. After a Local Club has voted, the **ACTUAL** number of votes cast will be sent to the Constitutional Delegates Meeting via a Delegate or Alternate Delegate. Votes can be collected from each member in person, via ballot, or electronically. The actual vote cast will be certified by the minutes of a Club Business Meeting or the minutes of the Club's Board. The vote count sent to the Constitutional Delegates' Meeting should only be the actual votes of members who participated in the election. If a member does not vote, no vote will be counted for them.

Each **Member at Large** will receive an electronic ballot on June 1, 2022, to vote for the two Constitutional amendments. Member at Large votes will be tabulated and presented at the Delegates meeting by the Region Officer of the members' primary address on file at HQ.
