- 14 Club members have not renewed in 2022 (Jeffrey & Margaret Choate, Darla & Todd Lewis, Bud & Donna Moore, Paul & Pam Richmond, Rick & Anne Schmidt, Elizabeth & Douglas Whitley, William & Linda Wilson)

So how does Piedmont NC Airstream Club get new members?

Airstream Club International (ACI) sends an email to Amy Mount, Bill Byrum and Stedman Brown when a new member selects Piedmont NC Airstream Club as their õLocal Club.Ö Amy then documents the new memberøs contact information (name, address, phone number & email address), Big Red Number (BRN), type of Airstream RV and date of membership within an Excel spreadsheet. Gregory Ray, Piedmont Club Corresponding Secretary, is then emailed the contact information for the new member so they can be included in the distribution list for the monthly Piedmont NC Club newsletter. Amy mails a õWelcome Letterö to the new member that includes a list of Piedmont NC Club rallies for the current year and contact information for our Club President, Bill Byrum, and Amy Mount, Club Membership. ACI sends each new member a õWelcome Packet,ö which includes a set of the Big Red Numbers, ACI name badges, a set of decals and the latest edition of the *Blue Beret* magazine.

Amy also sends letters, emails and texts to Club & Affiliate members to remind them to renew their Piedmont NC Club membership throughout the year. Club members will also receive an email from ACI when it is time to renew since ember renewal dates are now aligned with the date they joined Airstream Club International. However, Club members that joined **BEFORE** July 1, 2021 will still have a membership renewal date of January 1 each year.

Remember, ACI and Piedmont Club membership only lasts for *one calendar year*. If a member lets their membership lapse for more than 60 days, then they will be moved to a new renewal date and possibly a new Big Red Number if they return as a current ACI & Club member. Members may renew their membership through the ACI website, but ACI Membership will accept checks and payment with a credit card over the phone. ACI membership will continue to be \$75. Local Airstream Club dues, as well as Affiliate Member fees, will continue to be \$15 each. ACI members can be Affiliate members to multiple clubs.

The ACI Membership Directory on Airstream Clubøs website is a GREAT resource for every Piedmont Club member. You may search for a specific Club member by using their first and last name or Big Red Number and even get a list of Piedmont Club members and their contact information.

If a Club member provided an email address and/or phone number when becoming a õPrimary Memberö or õPartner Memberö then that information is now available within the online ACI Membership Directory. However, if a member did not include an email address and/or phone number for the õPartnerö member, then no communication will be sent to that Club member via email from ACI. Airstream encourages EVERY Club member, especially a "Partner Member" to include a valid email address as part of the member's contact information. This will allow BOTH the "Primary Member" and "Partner Member" to participate in Airstream Club International elections, receive Club communications, ACI promotions, etc. If you want to add a õPartner Memberö email address, please contact Airstream headquarters via email at membership@airstreamclub.org or call Amanda Hughes, ACI Membership Coordinator, at 937-596-5211.
