An Interview with NORVA 2nd Secretary Gail Perkins

Born in Jacksonville, NC

Gail has worked many jobs, to include: at an accountants office during her senior year of high school (Girl Friday), service rep. for the telephone company, Secretary to the Vice-President for Development at the University of Mary Washington, and provided child care for many years while her children were young.

Gail volunteered with the Fredericksburg Rescue Squad for 10 years and developed a love for taking care of people and the medical field. She went to nursing school and received her RN degree in 1989.



Gail immediately was accepted to work in the Emergency Department (ED) at Mary Washington Hospital in Fredericksburg, VA. While working in the ED, she met Doug Perkins who was a patrol officer for the Fredericksburg City Police Department. Gail also worked in the Post Anesthesia Care Unit (Recovery Room) for a few years.

Gail saw a need for a Forensic Program at Mary Washington Hospital. She received specialized training and was the first forensic nurse at Mary Washing Healthcare. She was Manager of the program. She hired and trained RN's to become Forensic Nurses to care for patients of violence, such as; sexual assault, domestic violence, elder abuse, child abuse, and gun shot & stabbing patients. She collected evidence, photographed injuries, and testified in court as an expert witness.

Gail was instrumental in the development and opening of Safe Harbor Child Advocacy Center in Fredericksburg. She brought a team of professionals together (Commonwealth Attorneys, Law Enforcement, Child Protective Services, Victim Witness Directors, and hospital administration) and after many years of planning and grant writing, Safe Harbor was opened to serve children of abuse in the community. Gail has served on the Board of Directors for Safe Harbor for many years. Children are taken to Safe Harbor instead of the police department or the Emergency Room to be interviewed on-site, to received trauma focused therapy, and can have their medical/forensic exam performed on site vs going to the ED.





Gail has received many awards and professional recognition in her nursing career. One she especially treasures is the National Spirit of Women Award. Out of many finalists throughout the country, Gail was presented this award in Boca Raton, FL for her outstanding care to victims of violence and the development and opening of Safe Harbor Child Advocacy Center.



After 30 years in the nursing/forensic field, Gail retired in 2018. Of course she had to have a party!!!







Gail now has time to enjoy may activities such as: fishing, paddle boarding, kayaking, walking Seneca – their 7 year old yellow Labrador retriever, attending family/grandkids events, and of course, camping in their Airstream.

RALLY FEES – \$435 for an RV On-Site with 30 amp electric, water, and pump-outs; \$130 for each Adult (18+); \$40 for each Youth 13-17; Free for Children (12 & Under).

ADA ACCESSIBLE PARKING – Special parking, if requested, is near the central rally area for members. We ask that you bring your government/state-issued placard or supporting documentation with you to the rally.

REGISTRATIONS – Through the courtesy of Airstream, Inc., members registered before the start of the rally are entered into a prize drawing. Over \$2,000 in gift certificates for parts and service will be given away. Registrants must be present at the Airstream presentation to win.

STAGING AREA – In an attempt to keep the rigs moving, you will receive a rally arrival date in the Spring of 2022. If you can't make it on that date, the Rally Arrival Team will be ready to park you when you arrive from 8:00 am to 8:00 pm. Arrivals after 8:00 pm may stay overnight in the Staging Area, with no hookups, until parking begins the next morning.

CANCELLATION POLICY – Refund requests received by May 28th, 2022, will be assessed a \$50.00 fee. Refund requests after May 29th, 2022, will be assessed a 50% fee. NO refunds after July 9th, 2022. *If you might have to cancel after that day, please consider obtaining travel insurance.*

RALLY PARKING DATES – General parking is tentatively scheduled to begin around July 20th. Parking dates will be sent via email in Spring 2022. Caravans of 5 or more need to contact HQ at <u>rally@airstreamclub.org</u> for arrival date.
