International Constitution and Bylaws Amendments

2022 Region 10 Airstream Club International Rally

Four days of fun, friendship, and all things Airstream at the Region 10 Airstream Club International Rally **June 1** – **5, 2022**. Airstream Region 10 includes over 1,000 Airstream owners in the western US and Canada.

We have confirmed the NW Washington Fairgrounds in Lynden, WA, as the site for our 2022 Rally. Lynden is located north of Bellingham, just south of the US/Canada border. 20 amp, water, and an on-site dump (\$5) are available. Clean bathrooms and showers on-site.

Lynden is home to Washington State's largest Dutch settlement. The Washington and Idaho clubs are co-hosting this rally. We anticipate hosting 150 Airstream owners, with space for a maximum of 80 Airstreams. We are planning days filled with events, seminars, social gatherings, tours, food, and entertainment.

An email will be sent out in January with a link to register. Start planning your caravans to this event that is located in the middle of lots of interesting areas to explore. A list of suggested campgrounds to stay along the way will be included in the registration information. The Canadian border is open and by next June, camping on both sides of the border will be in full swing so snag your Region Rally reservations in January, and book your before and/or after camping reservations ASAP as 2022 will be a busy camping season. Safety: SEVERE WEATHER & HAIL SEASON

The time is here for severe weather, and with it comes the risk of damaging hail. One hail storm can total an Airstream, so be sure to have a plan to protect it.

NOAA's Storm Prediction Center has a good website to check every day for potential severe weather threats. It shows the potential/likely areas to be affected, along with what kind of weather threat.

Sometimes it is impossible to completely outrun or avert a storm, but there are things that you can do to help be prepared to protect your Airstream. Keep in mind that tarps or blankets will do next to nothing to protect the aluminum from hail, and it will most likely put a lot of small scratches in the clear coat.

Make note of car washes, abandoned gas stations with awnings, and commercial buildings with big enough garages to fit your Airstream in. If you ask, they may make space for you and your Airstream. Just offer them some money. One place in Kansas wanted a case of beer. Most people are pretty nice, and it never hurts to ask. Even if they can't do it, they may know of another place nearby that can.

The author passed a place in East TX while moving his Airstream away from a severe hail threat and called them to ask if he could park it there overnight. They said yes and saved him hours of driving and a lot of money in fuel, and he made a new friend.

Finally, if a severe storm hits when you are in your Airstream, especially with a high wind or tornado threat, then seek shelter in a place other than your Airstream. We have all seen the pictures of what happens when severe wind or a tornado hits a mobile home or RV park. Airstreams are not a safe place in a severe weather situation.

Be safe out there, and have a plan.
