WELCOME AIRSTREAMERS!



In case of emergency for any reason, **call 911**. Give **911** your name, location (Fryeburg Fairgrounds, Fryeburg, ME), lot name and site number, and Big Red Number. Turn on your emergency flashers and headlights. Have a neighbor stand by to direct emergency personnel to your site.

After calling 911, call the International Vice President on-call, Eric McHenry or Per Hamqvist, at 937-710-2468 to inform them of the incident. They will help direct responders to your site.

Announcements: Important announcements will be made at the evening programs in the General Assembly (Mountain View Pavilion) prior to the evening program and will be sent as notifications on the Rally Event App, Grupio.

Badges: All persons attending the rally must wear badges and ribbons or (wrist bands for Day Passes) to be admitted to all venues and programs. Write your Big Red Number (BRN) on the back of the ribbon so that it can be returned if lost. New or replacement badges are available for purchase at Welcome. Guest badges can be obtained at the Member Services area in the Agriculture Exhibition Center. We also ask that you wear your badge in town so that local merchants know you are a member of the Airstream Club International.

Bicycle Excursions: Daily rides around the Fairground area are led by Will Kushto beginning on Wednesday, July 20. Riders meet at the Waterwheel Park at 7:00 am for a 90 minute ride.

Blood Drive: The Red Cross Blood Drive takes place in the air-conditioned Expo Center, with snacks and beverages provided for those who donate. Whether you've donated before or this is your first time, we welcome all to participate in this community service opportunity on Tuesday, July 26 or Wednesday, July 27 between 11 a.m. - 4 p.m. both days.

Dog Park: An off-leash dog park is located between Main St and the NW side of the racetrack. Friendly dogs are

welcome to romp and play but remember to clean up after them to keep the area nice for everyone.

Exhibitors: Visit the Rally Exhibitor Hall, located in the Craft Center, to learn about the latest and greatest products available to Airstreamers. They are open Saturday, July 23, from 9am to 4pm, through Friday, July 31. Be sure to stop by daily, as there are new pop-up vendors each day!

First Timers GAM (Get Acquainted Meeting): All first time international rally attendees are invited to attend the meet and greet social on Saturday, July 23, at 1:00pm in the Expo Center. Come mingle with other first timers and learn what to expect at the rally and ways to get involved. This event is hosted by members excited to help you navigate smoothly and get the most out of your first international rally.

Food and Clothing Drive: Contribute to our annual tradition of providing support to local groups and shelters by donating hats (homemade or store bought), stuffed animals, blankets or throws, women's shelter items, tabs (we cash them in for Ronald McDonald House), food pantry items and pet supplies for cats and dogs. Look for table in Welcome to drop off your items.

Food Service: A variety of food trucks and concession stands are on-site at the fairgrounds for all to enjoy! They are located south of Cross Rd; look for the yellow star on the map.

Friendship Center: Meet up with friends in the History Hall for games and socializing. This is the perfect place for a game of Joker, bridge, gin rummy, or to just sit and chat.

GRUPIO Mobile Event App: This is your best way to stay informed and get last minute changes. It includes the rally schedule with updates, lists of exhibitors, speakers, maps and more. Download from your app store and search for "Airstream" to find this event.

Jam Sessions: Join in any of the jam sessions scheduled Sunday through Wednesday evenings, 9 - 11 p.m. in the Mountainview Pavilion. Open to musicians and lovers of music of all ages, skill levels and instruments. This nightly get together brings music-loving members of our Airstream community together to jam on some favorite tunes, maybe learn a new one, and enjoy one another's company.

Lost and Found: Found items can be turned in to Member Services. Check here for lost items.

Mail Services: Mail and packages are available for pick up at Member Services, Agriculture Exhibition Center, until noon on Friday, July 23. Items are returned to sender if not claimed.

Member Services: Located in the Agriculture Exhibition Center, Member Services is your source for all information about the rally, club, and locale. If they don't have the answer to your questions, they have the resources to get the answers.

Parking Stickers: When you arrive, a sticker with a QR code is placed on the front and back of your RV. This is a surface-safe, sticker and will not harm the finish. This sticker must remain on the RV during the rally. The rally uses this for location information and to record pump-outs.

Pets at the Rally: All pets must be on 6-foot, non-retractable leashes when outside the Airstream. Always clean up after your pet. There is a dog park on the NW side of the racetrack (see map). Pets are not permitted in the buildings. Service dogs are welcome.

Propane: Propane is available at these locations:

- Camping World of Conway, 1571 E Main St, Center Conway, NH
- Coleman Rental and Supply, 1367 New Hampshire 16, Albany, NH
- White Mountain Oil, 2820 White Mountain Highway, North Conway, NH

Pump-out Service: Pump out services are scheduled for every 4 days but not guaranteed. Please try to conserve your tank space in case of a delay. You may request extra pumpouts at cost of \$35 each. Request forms are at Member Services and you pay at the Cashier.

Quilting and Fiber Arts: Quilters, sewists, makers, knitters, etc. Bring your latest project to Quilting and Fiber Arts in the Expo 5 Building. Quilting and Fiber Arts are held daily during the rally. Check the rally schedule for times.

Restrooms and Showers: Restrooms are located inside most buildings; see the map for details of locations, showers and handicapped access.

Severe Weather: In case of severe weather, proceed promptly to the Mountain View Pavilion or Livestock Show Arena buildings.

We are located in Oxford County. Use your NOAA weather alert radio to monitor for hazardous weather. Some Airstreamers use cell phone apps, such as Storm Shield, Accuweather, Wx Alert USA, Wunderground, The Weather Channel or MyRadar.

Use your best judgment about leaving the Airstream awning out while away from your rig. Unexpected high winds can damage your awnings and your awnings could then also damage other Airstreams while you are away. Secure awnings, flags, and all loose items around your RV.

Pets may be taken into the building but be prepared to accommodate their needs. Remember to bring a leash (maximum of 6 feet) for your pet(s).

Receive weather alerts from the Nixle notification system by texting Zip Code 04037 to 888777. To stop the alerts, text STOP to 888777.

Suggestion Box: There is a suggestion box located at Member Services. Cards are provided for your comments. All suggestions will be read by the Rally Planning Team and taken into consideration for future events.

Transportation: The rally provides transportation from the fairground camping areas to the rally activities area.

Volunteers: Near the Welcome tables, you'll find the Volunteer table with available volunteer opportunities and sign-up sheets. Many jobs require just three hours of your time. Volunteering is a great way to get involved, meet more fun people, and it's fun too!

Wi-Fi: Strong Wi-Fi exists in the main buildings but not in the general parking areas. Cell phone service is very good in the area so members are encouraged to use their cell phone hot spots or other mobile hot spots such as a Jetpack or MiFi. There is a Wi-Fi lounge at the northeast corner of the racetrack, near Green Gate #9, at the intersection of Paddock and Commercial Roads.

Worship and Reflection Center: Any member may reserve the Worship and Reflection Center located in the Garden Center. To make your reservation, please contact Interfaith Services Chair, Bob Stansbury at burytone@yahoo.com. Morning Devotions are daily at 7:45 am beginning Monday, 12 July 25.






