

Another motion that was approved was a Policy for Amending the Constitution. It was agreed that motions may be brought forward anytime during the year and considered, but a vote by the members will occur only 1 time per year.

The last motion to be approved dealt with changing the name of National Rallies. After much discussion, and additional amendments, the name is being changed to National Event Rallies.

A change to how IBT (International Board of Trustees) meetings will be conducted beginning with the August 1 year is the IBT meeting will be held quarterly instead of twice per year. They will be predominantly Zoom meetings with an in-person meeting scheduled for May 2023 at Jackson Center. I will update you on any changes either by unit newsletter or getting a Regional newsletter out.

Speaking of fun! Our Region Rally will be in Spring Green and I will nail the date down this week. I am looking for a planning committee to help with locations, crafts, meals, entertainment and all that fun stuff! Please let me know if you're interested in planning! Thanks!
