July-August 2022 President's Report

Hi Piedmont Club,

Enroute to Fryeburg 3 more rigs joined in. All total we had 11 rigs from the Piedmont Club attending the International Rally

The Piedmont Club was well represented in the activities of the rally. I represented the club in all the business meeting part of the rally, more on that later. Steve and Leslie Lovette did 2 dutch oven cooking seminars. Dick and Becky Martin had their RV Safety and Solar booth and Dick did presentations on solar and safety. Gail Broome, Jim and Amy Mount blessed us with participation in the rally choir. Mike Bizon was the MC for choir and orchestra program. Delia Rati won the animal photo contest and the overall best photo,. Peter Cap and Jim Mount drove the shuttle getting rally goers to all the various locations. And last but not least Diane represented the Sho-Me the Ozarks caravan in the poster area and she assisted with the Region 3 luncheon. Bob Ealy (affiliate member and Region 3 1st VP) caravanned with us to the rally. Bob attended business meetings and he and Ginger also assisted with the Region 3 luncheon. Now for the business end of the rally; the International Board of Trustees (IBT) meeting was fairly routine with the various committee reports. There were some motions related to bylaws changes, mostly administrative. The delegates meeting was held on Wednesday, July 27th. The delegates meeting is where the votes that you submitted on the 2 constitutional amendments were cast. There were 93 of 102 clubs represented (if my math is correct) plus the 12 regional VPs voting for members at large. The 2 amendments both passed. The first amendment pass by around 80% and the second amendment passed by around 70%. So what does this mean? Amendment 1 did away with the delegate voting system. So from a historical perspective, I represented the Piedmont club in the last ever delegates meeting. Amendment 2 changes the executive council structure. The current elected officers will serve a 1 year term and we will all get to vote for 10 executive council members in 2023. From the 10 executive council members the IBT will select the officers (president, VP, etc). The executive council will serve a 2 year term (elections will be held on odd years). If re-elected the officers can serve 2 consecutive terms. The real disappointing part of all of this is that out of 15,416 Airstream Club members only about 3500 actually voted.

The Piedmont Club will hold our last business meeting prior to the installation rally at the Sneed Ferry Rally in September.

Enough of the business!!! We have 2 remaining club rallies. The first is in Sneed¢ Ferry and is being hosted by Alan and Jane Hvizdak, September 8-11 at Sea Haven RV and Marina. The last rally of the year will be the installation rally at Salem Breeze RV Park in Winston Salem, November 3-6 hosted by David and Debbie Stubbs. Don¢ forget the Alumalina rally at Tom Johnson Camping Center in Marion NC, October 27-30. Hopefully you can make all three of these but if not (and Diane and I won¢ make Alumalina) I hope to see you at one of the club rallies.

- determine preferences for Airstream communication & Blue Beret via electronic or mail
