Plenty more to explore in Colorado and we'll be back for sure!







Airstream Cooking – Apple & Pumpkin Crumble

It's Fall – and that means Apples & Pumpkins galore! This sweet treat combines both into a delicious dessert – and easy to make while on the road! Just imagine the aromas wafting through the Airstream!

Filling Ingredients:

6 apples, peeled, cored and roughly chopped 1/3 c + 1 Tbls pumpkin puree (not pie filling) ½ tsp cinnamon ½ tsp ground ginger Topping: ³/₄ c all purpose flour ¹/₄ c butter, cold & cubed ¹/₄ c oats ¹/₄ c granulated sugar 1 tsp apple or pumpkin pie spice ¹/₂ tsp ground ginger

Spray a foil or casserole pan (8x8) with oil spray. Preheat oven to 400. Mix filling ingredient together and place in the pan. Combine topping flour & spices in separate bowl. With fingers, rub the butter in until it resembles bread crumb texture. Add oats and sugar. Sprinkle over top of filling and back 25 minutes or until bubbly and golden.
