Cost is \$35.50 per night for Water & 30 Amp Electric. No 50 amp service available. Pay online using the campground registration form.

Rally Campsites are being held until July 1st. After that, they will be released and open to general public registrations.

Northfield City Rally

At the end of June, we had what we believe is Minnesota's first urban Airstream rally in Northfield MN.

The Northfield Historical Society invited us to town in conjunction with their Fran Hall: Tin Can Traveler exhibit (running through December 2023 so you still have time to visit). While we were disappointed at first that the city wouldn't allow us to park on the streets, we've come to realize it was really a blessing in disguise... we were dry camping and it was HOT. Thankfully, we didn't have asphalt to heat us up more AND we had our saving grace: the wind coming across the river, which we wouldn't have had if parked on city streets.

Northfield is a vibrant, active town that has worked very hard to preserve their downtown and it shows. Everything you could ever want was within walking/biking distance (or a very short drive). Did you know that Northfield is the town that was the beginning of the end for the James Younger gang that robbed banks in the mid 1800's? The Historical Society in town is also a Museum that tells the story of how the townspeople stood up against the would-be bank robbers and a couple gang members met their demise that day. You can learn all about it AND see the Fran Hall exhibit that shows photos and offers personal insight from the official photographer of the Airstream "Around the World Caravan" of 1964.
