CLASSIC COCKTAILS – THE BRONX by Rich Giardina

An often overlooked, even unknown cocktail that predates Prohibition by a decade or so is the Bronx. In its day it was as popular as both contemporary rivals, the Martini and the Manhattan. It is still a wellbalanced and refreshing drink that ticks all the boxes...and that's what makes it a classic.



Ingredients

- 2 ounces gin
 - 1/4 ounce dry vermouth
- 1/4 ounce sweet vermouth
- 1 ounce orange juice, freshly squeezed
- 1 dash orange bitters (optional) •

Steps

- 1. Add the gin, dry and sweet vermouths, orange juice and orange bitters into a shaker with ice and shake until well-chilled.
- 2. Double-strain* into a chilled cocktail glass. *Pour through both the primary cocktail shaker strainer and a fine-mesh strainer over the cocktail glass to remove orange pulp.

During the 1990 season Marty created what may have been her best live show for everyone's Saturday evening enjoyment. She combined a fairy tale with a fashion show and came up with *Cinderfella*. It was based on *Cinderella* with a touch of *Red Riding Hood* in it. All the female parts were played by men, which earned extra laughs. Four women had parts, playing heralds who hummed into elongated kazoos when announcements were to be made. One player, normally played by a female, was meant to be a male – "Cinderfella."

The scenery was placed along the front of the counter and the opening into the kitchen. After a herald announced the next player the Royal Page who had been standing ready escorted that character forward, helped "her" step up onto a pedestal where "she" would turn and twist as Marty read the costume's description. Incidentally, Marty smoothly blended those descriptions with the story line to further the tale.

After each character finished turning and preening the Royal Page would escort "her" back behind the curtain, wait for the musical trumpeting then bring out the next character. Cinderfella was the first character to appear and he remained in view, off to the side. From time to time he would wail and sob, then squeeze the "tears" out of his wailing cloth. It is likely that only three names in that play are familiar to present day Unit members. Don Rinkes (Rinkes Trail) was Cinderfella. The Royal Page who also remained in view throughout the play was Everett Field, Doug's father. Only on view once to model "her" costume was Mrs. Charming, "mother" of the Prince, as played by J. R. Freeman.

For those who saw that production it surely remained a highlight of their rally experiences.

And now a new summer season of rallies begins, along with a new season of memories to be made. Have a great summer!
