It was a fantastic campground the Moses Austin Park and it was walking distance to the Historic town of Ste. Genevieve MO. Ste. Genevieve was founded in 1750 the oldest European settlement in the state of Missouri. Much of historic Ste. Genevieve charm is due to the preservation of features from the colonial settlement. Narrow streets and fenced gardens surround 18th-century French architecture.

The town has several houses on the National Historic Registry, that many of us toured. The Green Tree Tavern one of the oldest verified vertical log buildings in Ste. Genevieve, MO. It has officially been dated to 1790 by dendrochronology studies. The Ste. Genevieve Catholic Church founded in 1876, was beautiful with its stain glass

windows. There was the Tractor Museum, quaint little shops, excellent restaurants, and bakeries.

Saturday was the big day. It started with a book and bake sale at the First Presbyterian church. Several of us bought goodies and books. There were artisans in town working their crafts and selling items. There was basket weaving, making lace dollies, leather worker, making ropes, and cooking.

Saturday evening at the Ste. Genevieve's Old Memorial Cemetery was Déjà vu Spirit Reunion. It is where people dressed in the person, they were being the spirit of and telling their story by the grave site. This was quite interesting listening to their stories.

Also, some did the wineries, antique malls, some did the Baetje Farms tour of creamery, barns, goats, and a complimentary cheese tasting. Some of us drove down to where the Ferry crosses the Mississippi River to Illinois, but the Ferry was not running it was having maintenance done. There was so much history and things to do. We had Happy Hour and a fire every night.
