Pumpkin Pie Cakes and Pumpkin Pie Balls







PUMPKIN PIE CAKES

You'll need 2 pumpkin pies, whip cream and some kind of round cylinder object. (I'm going to use a large pill bottle).

Press down firmly on your pie and pull up small round pieces, arrange them on a plate and top with whip cream.







PUMPKIN BALLS

You'll need the leftovers from the two pies above, chocolate bark, wax paper and sucker sticks.

Fold in both pies together crust and all. After it's mixed well then form round balls and place in a bowl to freeze for several hours. When you're sure the balls are frozen then melt the chocolate in a microwave. Lay wax paper down. Take the balls out of the freezer and put the stick half way through the balls, dip them in the chocolate and lay on wax paper to dry.
