Nuts & Bolts

Zip-Dee Awning Maintenance (manual awning)



Zip-Dee awnings are one item on our AIRSTREAMS that don't get the proper care and treatment they deserve. They are pretty much trouble free until one day something doesn't move as smoothly as it should and we hit the panic button.

With camping season slowing down for a lot of our members, I figured you might want to do a little maintenance on your manual awning.

In this edition of Nuts and Bolts, I want to share with you some tips to keep your awning in good condition and working properly.

First, we will start with the hardware. The hardware of our awnings is anything that is not fabric. It needs to be cleaned and lubricated. The procedure is pretty simple. Wipe off all parts that you can reach and it is okay to use soap and water to clean off stubborn dirt.

Use an aerosol silicone lubricant to spray on anything that you cannot wipe off. Do not use WD-40 or some other petroleum-based product as they will collect dust and dirt! The telescoping bars and tubes of each arm can be taken apart one at a time and cleaned off. Sometimes a scotch-brite pad can be used to slick things up. You can also flush out the inside of the tubes with your garden hose.

from page 3 A little silicone spray is also a good thing to use here. You should also flush and spray parts that do not come apart, for example the snap studs, and the ratcheting studs need to be sprayed with silicone. Flush out with water the springs in the rafter arms and then spray with silicone. These springs are near the claw shaped casting at the end of the rafter arms. Do not forget about the middle rafter arm for those of you who have one on your main awning. In general, spray silicone lubricant on anything that moves or rotates. The ends of the roller arm are a great example of something that needs lubricating. You should also spray in between two moving parts. Shoot some silicone in all the gaps that you can find. Use the silicone spray freely as it will not hurt a thing. You can wipe off the excess with a clean, dry cloth.

If the aluminum parts start looking a little dull, you can try to use a good chrome polish to help bring back some of the shine. If you do not have any chrome polish, spray some silicone on the chrome parts to give them a little shine up. Finally, use a 7/16 socket wrench to check the tightness on every nut and bolt that you can see. This about does it for the hardware.

Next steps are just a few tips about the fabric.

Care of the fabric is not that difficult. Just a monthly hosing off with nothing but water will keep the fabric looking good. If you do this you will avoid having to do a deep cleaning of the fabric. Remember that the fabric is Sunbrella fabric, so it does not support mildew but dirt, leaves and bird droppings do.

Should your fabric require more that just a rinse off with water, here are a few tips for deep cleaning the fabric. Start by brushing off the loose dirt, and hosing down the awning, scrub with a soft bristle brush using a solution of one gallon of warm water and 1/4 cup of natural soap. Do not use detergents or commercial awning cleaners! Allow the soap and water solution to soak in by rolling up the awning and keep closed for about 10 to 15 minutes. Open back up and rinse very, very thoroughly. Let awning air dry; it will not take very long. It is recommended that the deep cleaning of the fabric be done about once every one to two years.

All of this information is in your Zip-Dee awning manual if you need to reference it.

Finally, a few tips about the operation of your awning. People always want to know two things about the awning. How much wind can the awning handle? How much rain can the awning handle? There are technical answers to both of these questions if you care to research it. My question to all of my Airstream friends is pretty simple; "Why risk it ?" Nothing will ruin your trip quicker than having a storm come tearing through the campground and destroy your awning because you did not take 5 minutes to put it away. If you have even the slightest doubt, just put it away. Also, do not ever go away for an extended time and leave your awning out!

For more information on a parts list or manuals you can contact Zip-Dee at 1-800--338-2378. I have called them on numerous occasions and I will say their customer service is great!

As always, I hope you find this information helpful and can use it as a starting point for the maintenance of your awning. Safe travels and see you all at a rally somewhere in this great country of ours!






We have been Airstreaming for 3 years. We have a 2020, 30' Classic we bought from John's RV in South Carolina. We love our rig, we call it Winston.

Salmon Stew

(Tastes just like She Crab Soup)

Ingredients:

2 (14 oz.) cans pink salmon (reserve the juice to add to soup) 3-4 potatoes, med. to lg. in size (more if you'd like) 1 lg. onion, grated 1 stick butter 1 lg. can evaporated milk (rinse can with 1/2 cup water and use) 2-3 cups milk, whole or skim or whatever you use (you may use all eva



whatever you use (you may use all evaporated milk if you like, rinsing can with water as above)

Salt and pepper to taste

Directions:

Peel and grate the potatoes and onion, coarsely. Put those ingredients on the stove with a stick of butter, the milks, and the juices from the salmon. Heat slowly, stirring often to avoid sticking or scorching. Clean the salmon and add to milk mixture. Add salt and pepper to taste. Increase heat and continue to stir often. Cook until potatoes and onions are done.

Serve with saltine crackers or oyster crackers.

Individuals may want to add ketchup, Texas Pete or Tabasco, if desired. Serves 6-8.

Ingredients:

One large bag of mini marshmallows

Melt 2/3 bag marshmallows and save the other 1/3 to mix with Golden Grahams. See directions below.

6 Tbsp. butter One 12 oz. bag milk chocolate chips 1/3 cup Karo light syrup

1 tsp. vanilla

One 16 oz. box Golden Grahams
