Join us for a Four-night Spring Rally in the beautiful Coastal Redwood Forest across the creek from Henry Cowell State Park in the hills above Santa Cruz. Family-owned and operated Smithwoods is a great place to gather and explore the amenities of this area.

First:

Start by booking your site directly with the resort. When you *call*, let them know you are with the Central Coast California Airstream Club, CCCAC.

They will need to know your rig's length as they will assign the sites based on the length of your rig in the group area reserved. If you go to their website you can see the area circled in red that has been reserved. As it is "off season" three nights get a fourth night free!!! With group rate (-10%) = \$58 + tax = \$62.64 = total \$187.92 { they will reach out for a \$50 deposit about 6 weeks before the event} Pet fee \$2 per night
