Wednesday (March 15)

- **1pm** - Earliest check-in time
- **6pm** - Informal mixer. Bring a chair and drinks to the barn. A table will be available for those that want to share their libations.

Thursday (March 16)

- Tastings and tours. Consult your favorite search engine or guide for wineries, breweries, and distilleries. Many area wineries open as early as 10am and get busy quickly.
- **1pm** - Earliest check-in time for new arrivals
- **6pm** - Informal mixer. Bring a chair and drinks to the barn. A table will be available for those that want to share their libations.

Friday (March 17)

- **Noon** - Consider lunch in Calistoga before tasting at Clos Pegase. Calistoga is a great little walkable town with many nice restaurants. Travel time to Clos Pegase is max. 5 minutes from Calistoga.
- **1pm - Group tasting at Clos Pegase in Calistoga.** Allow at least 30 minutes to drive there from the campsite. The Silverado highway route is recommended. The tasting will be at a discounted rate of \$71.25 per person. The fee will include a tour of the property, caves, and a seated tasting in the caves. Limited to 20 people. Pay the winery directly upon visiting.
- **1pm** - Earliest check-in time for new arrivals
- **6pm-ish** - Happy hour. Bring a chair, drinks, and an appetizer to share to the barn. A table will be available for those that want to share their libations.
- **Dusk** - Spontaneous campfires. Bring your propane fire pit to the barn to share or set up at your site for people to stop by.

Saturday (March 18)

- **Noon - Group tasting at Mangels Vineyard.** Allow 30 minutes to drive there. Bring a picnic lunch. Plan to stay a long time and enjoy the winery and wine. Tasting is \$10 per person and is payable directly to the winery upon visiting
- **6pm** - Potluck dinner. Bring a dish to share with the group (don't forget serving utensils). Show off your best dish and culinary talent. A table will be available for those that want to share their libations, too.
- **Dusk** - Spontaneous campfires. Bring your propane fire pit to the barn to share or set up at your site for people to stop by.

Sunday (March 19)

- Goodbyes
- **11am** - latest check-out time
