## Report on the "Common Sense for Kids" program

Thanks to the work of **Linda Poage** and **Christine Embers**, we have some answers to the questions posed by club members regarding the Common Cents For Kids status.

It is true and disappointing that no Common Cents monies were distributed during the cancelled 2020 Loveland Colorado Rally and the 2021 rally in Lebanon Tennessee. This appears to be primarily due to the lack of a coordinator during that time. The previous coordinator had resigned due to medical problems, and the new Youth Services coordinator chose not to include Common Cents as part of his responsibilities. No one was in charge.

When the WBCCI Foundation was started, Common Cents was included in their goals as of June of 2022. All monies collected prior to that date had been held in a separate fund by the WBCCI. During the interim, (2000 – 2022), our Region 8 held our contributions separate until the coordination of Common Cents For Kids funds was finalized. Those funds were released to the foundation a few months ago. Our club was not made aware of Region 8's decision to hold on to funds and that will be addressed directly at the next Region 8 meeting. Ultimately, they did arrive at the designated account.

In 2022, monies were distributed to the following recipients at the Fryeburg Maine Rally:

- Jen's Friends of Conway NH Direct assistance to four children currently fighting cancer Assistance includes travel to and from treatment, durable medical equipment and prescriptions not covered by medical insurance. All patients are in the Mount Washington Valley.
- Laura Foundation for Autism and Epilepsy Madison NH Donation will be used for their 3-part summer program where children are taught social skills, adaptive PE and other physical activities like therapeutic horseback riding, adaptive bike riding and wall climbing.
- Starting Point for Victims of Domestic Violence and Sexual Abuse Conway NH support includes education and prevention in area schools as well as support of families leaving domestic abuse. This program primarily covers western Maine.

Each program received a \$3500 grant each.

In the past, specific fund recipients were identified and introduced at each International Rally – that practice will not continue due to privacy issues that constrain agencies we are working with at local venues. All monies are now within a 501(3)c registered Non-profit. The good news is that any contribution that individual club members make can be tax deductible. If you desire to get a tax deduction for your contribution, these should be made directly to the fund, not through our local club, until a record keeping process for that purpose can be created.

Current Monies – from an email to Linda from Karen Fisher, Foundation President – 10/6/22.

"In early June 2022, \$19,199.92 was transferred from the Club to the Foundation. There have been some smaller donations made to Common Cents For Kids but the biggest donations were received at the IR and totaled \$8607.04." Current balance in Common Cents for Kids as of August 31, 2022, is \$17,570.55. The Foundation Board had hoped to take this balance down more after the grants presented at the IR, but the donations from some of the regions and local clubs far exceeded our expectations. We will continue to work at reducing this balance over the next few years as we feel that is not our place to hold onto the money but to get it out there to help others."

Jane Bartlett, the Region 7 and 8 Representative to the Foundation and Treasurer for the St Louis Airstream Club spoke with us at length and shares our concerns about how and where funds will be distributed and will take our concerns to the Council governing the Foundation.

One other detail discovered during our discussions was that nowhere in the club constitution or by laws was there ever any mention of Common Cents for Kids nor was there any written guidance regarding the parameters for giving out these funds. We are very lucky to have had dedicated stewards for these funds as no charter directing the processes was ever formally presented.

The only notation in the Bylaws is as follows:

• "The International Rally Committee may make a donation to the host community. This donation is in addition to those given to various local or national organizations by club groups such as, community service and Family and Youth Committee. Any donation from a religious service collection will be the responsibility of the collectors. (See Policy, 16.6.4, Rallies, Sec F, Item 22 for documentation of donations.) (6/24/20)"

And in the Policy and Procedures it is as follows:

 "Common Cents for Kids Fund will accumulate residual contributions from the Youth Charity Projects for any excess over \$6,000 collected in a given year. This fund will serve as a reservoir from which to access funds for years in which youth collections do not reach the \$6,000 limit. Interest from this fund shall accrue to this fund. Withdrawals from this fund will be authorized by the Family and Youth Standing Committee Chair and two members of the committee present. (7/5/02)"

The Missouri-Kansas Airstream Club Common Cents for Kids ad hoc committee feels that the plan going forward meets the intent of the legacy given to us by the Kennedys so many years ago. The grants made in 2022 and the transparency that we found with the Foundation President and our Region Representative was exactly what we were hoping to find. We will be watchful and continue to monitor the Foundation activities, for this and their other objectives.
