Greetings INWAC members and friends,





Balloon Adventure!

Theo and Yvonne Theodor's bucket list included the balloon fiesta in Albuquerque. They asked their fellow NWAC members if they would like to join in the fun. Thus, the 50th Albuquerque International Balloon Fiesta 2022 Rally was from the INWAC was 'launched'. The real adventure began on January 5th with 2 computers, coffee and breakneck typing to try to reserve spots for six Airstreams. (They were aware that there is a ACI National Airstream Balloon Fiesta Rally but knew the chances were slim that all who wanted to get in would be able to.) Yvonne and Theo were lucky to be able to reserve six spots for the opening weekend, September 30 to October 3, 2022. As they watched online that morning, within 90 minutes 20,000 campsites were reserved and another 5,000 trailers were waitlisted.

The Theodors planned a route and sights to see; Great Basin, Zion, Bryce, North Rim Grand Canyon, and Mesa Verde National Parks that others could follow, if they chose, finally meeting up at Enchanted Trails RV Park and Trading Post in Albuquerque. Each trailer received a goodie bag containing a hot air balloon spinner and a pair of wine cups. The next morning they caravanned into Balloon Fiesta Park with hot air balloons already floating above them in the air.

The schedule included getting up early for Dawn Patrol to see the morning glow, mass ascension and just being in complete awe of the magnificent balloons from all over the world including special shapes which included a sloth, a pink elephant, and Yoda, as well as more traditional hot air balloons. The evenings were just as spectacular with aerial drone light shows, fireworks, and skydivers.

Several members took a tram to the highest peak, Sandia Peak. This peak is the 10,378-foot crest of the Sandia Mountains. Sandia is Spanish for watermelon. When the sun sets the mountains have a pinkish hue reminiscent of a watermelon. Later that evening everyone met at a restaurant, La Reforma, for drinks and a delicious Mexican meal.

Shopping was had by all! Souvenirs at the fiesta included; t- shirts, wood carvings from the chainsaw carving show and a visit to the Pandora booth for the special 50th anniversary charm. Some ventured into town for one of the best arts and crafts shows in the country; Rio Grande Arts and Crafts Festival. Trips were also made to downtown Albuquerque and surrounding areas. We even tried a local delicacy, green Chile bread made by a gentleman for years at Golden Crown Panaderia.

Don Reynolds surprised his wife, Liz, with a special treat, a ride in a hot air balloon. Liz describes it as a trip of a lifetime!

Before they each streamed north toward home or to continue their travel adventures, President Russ and First Lady Robin Lea gifted each trailer a fiery Chile pepper ristra. It was our first out of state long distance rally and it was amazing.

#### A brief history about AIBF

"The events now known as balloon glows were invented in Albuquerque in 1979 when local pilots inflated balloons on Christmas Eve night as a thank you to local residents. The sight of balloons lit from within at night like giant holiday ornaments is breathtaking and glow events are now held all over the world. Balloon Fiesta launched its Balloon Glow, the world's biggest, in 1987." https://balloonfiesta.com/Balloon-Glows

"Balloon Fiesta Park's launch field alone is comparable to the size of 54 football fields. This 60-plus acre area is necessary to accommodate the more than 500 balloons that launch during the event (including 19 brand new "special shapes," such as an alien, a screwdriver and a flying bus). The total expanse of the Park is a whopping 365 acres, custom designed to facilitate the largest ballooning event on earth.




From the Membership Chair
