Thanks for allowing me to serve as your Treasurer for the next season. Amy and I have enjoyed meeting each of you and so look forward to every rally we can attend!!

There are many new faces now. What a blessing.

I thought I would share a few thoughts as to how Piedmont Clubøs Rally Fees are calculated and received.

Rally fees are calculated based upon the costs that the rally hosts incur. These fees could include costs for the food they prepare or possible entrance fees for events we attend. Most rally fees are under \$50 per person.

The rally hosts will provide me with the receipts for their costs. I will split the fees up based upon how many are attending the rally. **PLEASE NOTE:** Piedmont Club members that attend a Club rally for the first time will have their rally fees paid by the club. (We voted on this process during a previous business meeting.)

The rally fees will be rounded up to the next logical amount by the Club Treasurer. The rally hosts will provide each rally attendee with the dollar amount for the rally fee so you may prepare your payment. Checks are preferred, but cash can be taken. Checks should be payable to: Piedmont NC Airstream Club

We currently have a bit over \$6,000 in our clubøs account. Several of us have discussed, at Club business meetings, keeping a minimum balance in our account and disbursing any balance above \$4,000 to charities of the Clubøs choosing.

Please send me your ideas for charitable organizations, both national and local, via text or email. I will consolidate a list and share it with Bill Byrum, our Club President, so it may be discussed at a future business meeting.

We have all been blessed in so many ways and giving back would honor the traditions of what being an Airstreamer is all about.
