65th Annual Urbanna, VA Oyster Festival Rally November 3-6, 2022

We just received good news that the owner of the land we camp on for our Urbana Oyster Festival Rally has extended an offer for us to hold our rally on his land this year. This will be the 65th year the Urbana Oyster Festival is held. The festival itself is a two day event, being held 4-5 November, with an anticipated 50,000 people attending. The dates for our rally will be

3-6 November. With the large number of people attending, roads leading to our camp site, which is close to the festival activities, are largely closed to traffic once the festival begins. We try to have everyone parked the day before the festival. This is a dry camping event (no hook-ups) but in all the years we participated that has never been an issue. Last year we had twenty-six Airstreams (from all four Virginia clubs) parked in the field behind the Urbanna Firehouse. This will be the second year our Tidewater Club will host the rally. We expect to be offered 30 parking spots this year and will open participation to the first 30 Airstreamers who confirm their desire to participate. Amendment 2: 47 voted YES; 53 did not vote (considered an abstention)

Amendment 1: 2765 voted YES; 800 voted NO Amendment 2: 2557 voted YES; 1000 voted NO

TO RECEIVE THIS SPECIAL RATE, AND GET ONE OF THE RALLY RESERVED SITES, YOU MUST MENTION THAT YOU ARE PART OF THE "REGION 3 AIRSTREAM" GROUP. DO NOT BOOK ONLINE. ONLINE REGISTRATION WILL NOT ALLOW YOU TO RESERVE A SITE IN THE RALLY SECTIONS.

All sites are paved, so they don't designate any handicapped site parking. Ocean Lakes also rents golf carts to help you get around the park.

Online Rally Registration will be available after January, 2023. Rally fees will be due at registration. We prefer that you register online.
