Greetings Mountaineers!

We've been able to fill in some of the blanks in our 2023 Event Calendar, so we're sending it out now since some of the items call for prompt action on your part.

NEMAC 2023 Events Calendar

The January 2 edition included information about the Boothbay/Shore Hills rally May 19-21, and the September 29-30 Foliage boondock rally in Newport. Today's updated edition includes the following:

July 14-16 rally at *Woodland Acres* in Brownfield, ME – "Family camping in the foothills of the White Mountains, with swimming, canoeing, and fishing on the Saco River. The best camping Maine has to offer!" Their website tells the story: woodlandacres.com They are holding 15 sites for us, #66-87 They show as tent sites on the map but have been converted to RV with water & electric – good for up to a 35' rig. To make a reservation, email <u>info@woodlandacres.com</u> with your name, address, phone number and the length of the camper. Mention Roger Nagy and the Airstream rally. The cost is \$55 night.

August features *Camping on the Battenkill*, another river-oriented setting, **August 4-6**. Paul Hynek has arranged to have 15 sites reserved for us (until 1/31), as follows:

- OF9,8,6,5 & 4 (water and electric, on the big field)
- 7A and 1A (water and electric, on the big field)
- 40, 39, 38 (water and electric, in the woods)
- 13B, 14B, 15B, 16B, 21B (full hookup, wooded sites)

These sites are outlined on the attached camping map. To reserve a site, call Alan at 802 375-6663 by 1/31/23 The informative website is campingonthebattenkill.com

The campground is in Arlington VT, a short distance south of Manchester and north of Bennington.

We can provide more information about the foliage boondock event at **Kingdom Brewing September 29-30**. Melissa Corbin writes:

"Kingdom Brewing is the only operational brewery on a functioning farm in the state of Vermont. We expect this timing to be peak foliage in the Northeast Kingdom. Camping spots will all be within walking distance to the brewery taproom. Newport and Lake Memphremagog are within minutes driving distance.

"There will be 4 pods of 4 rigs for a total of 16 spots. Each pod will have a fire pit to share between the 4. There are no hookups. You must be able to back into the sites, they are not pullthrough. Pricing is \$70 for the weekend and includes live music both Friday and Saturday night in the taproom and one wood fired flatbread served in the brewery. Spaces are limited and will be reserved on a first-come basis by contacting melissa.y.corbin@gmail.com (please include Kingdom Camping in the subject).

"We will also be offering a sweatshirt specially designed and printed for this weekend's rally. Please indicate if you would like a sweatshirt and the size. The cost should likely be around \$25 or \$30 each depending on how many we order. All sweatshirts need to be pre-ordered as we use a print on-demand company." And finally, we've added an **October 6-8 trip to the shore, Burlingame State Park in Charlestown, RI –** a 15 minute bike ride to some outstanding RI beaches. Again, it will be dry camping in a beautiful setting. The park closes for the year on the 8th, so it will be a last hurrah, and a great way to close out NEMAC's camping event. Reservations through reserveamerica.com – there appears to be great availability now in the Legiontown Rd target area, sites 689--701.
