

# Meet the President

Gerry Nagel is currently NORVA's President. He and Patsy have been active in NORVA since they joined in 2017 after they bought their 25 Foot RB Twin International Serenity. At the RV show in Washington, DC in 2017, Gerry ran into a gentleman who was wearing a University of Florida jacket and that started a conversation since Gerry graduated from there. The gentleman was Lloyd Ulrich who happened to be the President of NORVA at that time. Even though Gerry and Patsy were sold on the Airstream this added more reasons as the club would be a way to learn about the Airstream and camping as neither had done this before.

Gerry served as 2nd. VP in 2019 and he and Patsy led a 16-day club caravan "PA/NY Potpourri" which started in Lancaster, PA and traveled to Corning/Watkins Glen, NY, Cooperstown and Herkimer, NY and finished in the Hudson Valley area with visits to FDR home and library, Culinary Institute of America, 9/11 Memorial and West Point. He has also served as 1st VP, President, Past President and is now on his 2nd tour as President.

Gerry graduated from the University of Florida in 1970 and entered the Army in January 1971 as a Medical Service Corps Officer. He attended Rotary Wing Officer Training (Helicopter) and graduated with honors in June 1972. His career spanned 24 years with aviation assignments in Medical Evacuation units in Nha Trang Viet Nam, Fort Stewart, GA, Scofield Barracks, HI, Enewetak Atoll, Marshall Islands, and Grafewnwoehr, Germany. Gerry also was a research aviator at the Aeromedical Research Laboratory at Fort Rucker, AL.

His non-flying assignments were Commander, 547th Medical Company (Clearing) at Fort Stewart, GA which was an Army Corps medical holding facility, personnel officer at the Army Medical Personnel Support Agency in Washington, DC, and Plans and Operations Officer at the 98th General Hospital in Nuremberg, Germany. His last assignment in the Army was with the US Army Drug and Alcohol Operations Agency as the Drug Program Manager for the Army's Drug Deterrence Program located Alexandria, VA.

After retiring from the Army in 1995 Gerry did some consulting work and became the operations officer on a contract supporting the Public Health Service Division of immigration Health. This position was responsible for hiring medical support personnel to work in health clinics at several immigration processing centers.

In 2000 Gerry became the Drug Deterrence Program Manager for the US Secret Service. He was in this position for six years and then moved to the US Department of Agriculture and ran their drug deterrence program for 9 years. He retired from government service in 2015 and started part-time with Pembrooke Health Service as a drug testing collector. Patsy joined him in this endeavor after she retired from government service in 2018.

Patsy's favorite National Park is the Smokey Mountains where we like to hike and go Elk watching in the fall.





# Membership Director's Report

Membership Update. As Calendar Year 2022 ended, so did the window for most (but not all) NORVA members to renew and pay WBAC and NORVA dues for continuing membership into 2023. Let me explain. Most people currently in NORVA first joined the Club prior to July 1, 2021. They are required to pay dues by Dec. 31st annually, to cover Club participation for the next calendar year. However, in Summer 2021, WBAC implemented a computerized system for adding "new" memberships and tracking existing members.

#### Here's how it works:

For "newer" members who first joined the club on or after July 1, 2021:

Your annual membership period and dues renewal are based on your "first joined on..." anniversary. If your household falls in this category, annual renewals and dues payments must be accomplished each year on or before the anniversary of when you first joined. For example, let's say you first joined WBAC and NORVA as a new member on Sept. 3, 2022. Thereafter you pay renewal dues on or before Sept. 3rd annually, and that will cover your membership through Sept. 2nd of the coming year.

For "older" members who joined WBAC and NORVA prior to July 1, 2021: You are still required to renew membership and pay dues on or before Dec. 31st each year, which covers your continued membership through the next calendar year.

In both cases, WBAC Headquarters will send you e-mail reminders about renewing well in advance of your approaching renewal deadline.

For now, the Club is employing these two different membership renewal tracks. Over time, the Club will reach a point where all member-households are on the "first joined on" anniversary system. The transition is ongoing because all membership tasks are now computer-processed using the airstreamclub.org website. The shift to having renewals spaced throughout the year (instead of having every household meet a Dec. 31st deadline) eliminates the need to compute how much a new member must pay for a partial year when they first join. It will also spread-out record keeping and dues collection tasks over a full 12 months, easing what is now a year-end crunch on the WBAC headquarters staff, membership directors, and club treasurers. That said, NORVA will still take a measure of our Club's membership on January 1st of each year to determine who is aboard and still covered on that date by the dues they last paid.

Statistically, where does NORVA's membership stand at the start of 2023? As of January 1st, NORVA has a total of 96 member-households.

- 74 have NORVA as their "home club."
- 22 are "Affiliate" members of NORVA. Other WBAC clubs are their "home clubs," or they are "MALs" (Members-at-Large). They also opt to be NORVA affiliate members and pay NORVA dues.
- Virginia Club #109 reports they caught up with us and had 96 member-households on Jan. 1, 2023.

At year's end, 2022, NORVA listed 114 member-households on the roster, but 18 did not renew. The majority of those dropping out had sold (or were in the process of selling) their Airstreams. Others moved out of the area, transitioned to other clubs, or elected to disassociate locally and become WBAC Members-at-Large.

The 2023 NORVA Directory is going to the print shop now that we have accounted for each memberhousehold. The publication will contain listings and photos of all members officially on NORVA's roster on Jan. 1, 2023. It is scheduled to be printed commercially later this month. USPS mail distribution to each household's address will occur in early February.

As was reported in the December 2022 issue of NORVA News (page 13), the cost to receive one copy of the 2023 Directory was included in the NORVA dues you've already paid. However, members can opt to receive an additional copy (or copies) for \$9 each, which will offset the added cost of printing and mailing the extra copies. Having two directories would mean you could keep one at home and one in your Airstream.






# **COMMONWEALTH RALLY**

Campsite Daily Rate: \$42 ++

Works out to \$50.53 per day when taxes and fees are included. All sites have Full Hookups.

**Please BOOK NOW** to lock in your preferred campsite and special daily rate. We will be in Section E (Green Section). https://endlesscaverns.com/campground-map/ Prefer a pull-through to a back-in campsite? No problem, we negotiated the same rate for all sites.

A one-night deposit is required to reserve your campsite. The rate will be honored for stays from September 19 to September 26, 2023 (up to 2 days before and up to 2 days after the rally).

Due to the unique topography of this mountainside campground, please arrive to park your airstream at the campsite during daylight hours. Note the actual campsites are terraced and therefore reasonably flat, so just your usual leveling blocks will be needed if at all. We have reserved only 60 campsites. Once the 60 spots are taken, we will create a waiting list. Registration deadline is August 12, 2023. Most rally group events will be held at the campground's rec center building which has plenty of parking.


