WHAT'S COOKING?

PUMPKIN FRENCH TOAST

You can easily cook French toast over a fire if you have a cast iron skillet. Just melt some butter in the pan before you start and add more as necessary.

Ingredients:

- 4 eggs
- 1/4 cup milk
- 1/4 cup pumpkin puree
- 1 tsp. pumpkin spice blend (or a pinch of cinnamon, nutmeg, ginger, and cloves)
- 1/2 loaf of sliced bread

Beat the eggs, milk, puree, and spices together. If the mix is too thick for your taste, add a bit more milk to thin it out. Next, dip the bread into the mixture, and thoroughly coat both sides. Drop it into the cast iron skillet and toast both sides.

AIRSTREAMS ON PARADE

Who would have ever imagined that three tiny Airstreams could have generated such enthusiasm from countless strangers on sidewalks? The eruptive occasion was the 69th Autumn Leaf Festival Parade[©] held in Clarion, Pennsylvania, on October 1, 2022; and three Pennsylvania Airstream Club members stepped forward as "marchers" to bring attention to the many rewards of Airstreaming. Our club's community awareness effort created a surprisingly raucous reaction from the miles of applauding spectators and a shockwave over our Airstream owners on parade.

Karl and Beth Ludwig's 2016 Basecamp led the group, followed by Marc and Becky Weimer's vintage 1963 Globe Trotter towed by their classic 1968 Dodge Polara, and "caboosed" by Doug and Cindy Field's vintage 1967 Caravel. The Airstreams, group number 134 in line, were placed in marching order at 10AM on a Clarion side street; and the front of the parade started to process up the parade route at Noon. In those waiting hours in the chilly, misty air, there were numerous spectators who approached to ask about the trailers. There is something to be said about bringing your warm kitchen and bathroom with you while waiting for the parade to begin. No port-a-pottie lines!

Afterward, PAC agreed that we should make this an annual community-outreach event, and our application is being submitted for next year's parade on October 7, 2023. We hope to add a few more rigs to the train, maybe an Airstream motorhome and a newer, larger Airstream. Is yours available for a few hours of community outreach next year? CONSTITUTION AND BYLAWS AMENDMENTS

The PAC will conclude its Special Email Meeting on December 3, 2022, for the purpose of presenting and voting upon the proposed 2022 PAC Constitution and Bylaws Amendments. According to WBCCI / ACI guidelines, each local club must conduct a review of these governing documents every five years; and we look forward to completing our review process shortly. If you are a Regular Member of the Pennsylvania Airstream Club, you should have received via email or first-class mail the proposed amendments to both documents for your review and return vote in support of, or opposition to, the proposed amendments. We encourage those who have yet to vote, or who request a resend of those documents, to please contact PAC Secretary Mary Wilson at marywunit91@gmail.com or phone 814-571-1168 before December 1, 2022.

The Constitution amendments include 1) changing all references to "PA Unit" to "PA Airstream Club;" 2) removal of references to "co-owners" as PAC has none; 3) increase board members' terms, if elected, to up to four (4) one-year terms for officers and up to two (2) two-year terms for directors; and 4) allow recognized voting PAC members unable to attend meetings in person to submit votes on matters via email (electronically), regular mail, or facsimile prior to two (2) days before the meeting.

Bylaws amendments include 1) "PA Unit" to "PA Airstream Club;" 2) to clarify that the PAC Executive Board may amend the Bylaws by a twothirds vote following receipt of such amendments in writing at least 10 days prior to such vote; and 3) removal of Article VI, Delegates, section following WBCCI's removal of delegate votes at its WBCCI annual meetings.

Thank you to those who have already cast their votes.

WE NEED A NEW PAC LOGO

Just prior to the pandemic, PAC had initiated an informal look at developing a new club logo/flag. It fell off the radar for a while, and we would like to see it brought back to the front burner. Board members have touched upon a preference for the logo, and hence the flag, to reflect the club's connection to the campground, i.e., some element of the campground worked in.

Do you have an artsy flair and a willingness to work with another member on this one-time volunteer project? This is something that could even be worked on remotely. Ideally, two or three designs would be presented to the PAC Board and membership for an eventual vote prior to flag production.
