## Nuts & Bolts

Submitted by Terry & Annie Montgomery and Bruce (BRN 3156)

#### Maintenance Items and Schedule:

- A. Every 1,000 miles or 60 days, the following should be done;
- 1. Check the operation of the escape window.
- 2. For lead acid batteries check the water level.
- 3. Smoke alarm and CO detector, check the battery and replace as needed.
- 4. Check tire pressure by following mfg. specifications.
- **B.** Every 5,000 miles or 90 days, the following should be done;
- 1. Lubricate the main door latch with dry graphite or silicone.
- 2. Spray the exterior door locks and lubricate with a product like Houdini.
- 3. Lubricate the LPG hold-down with a light household oil.
- 4. Check the bottom vent on LPG regulator for obstructions.
- 5. Torque wheel lug nuts: Aluminum wheels to 110 ft. lbs., steel wheels to 100 ft. lbs.
- 6. Lubricate break-a-way switch pin with household oil.
- 7. Spray 7 way pin with contact cleaner.
- 8. Lubricate hitch ball with wheel bearing grease.
- 9. Lubricate and inspect the doorstep.
- **C.** Every 10,000 miles or 6 months the following should be inspected: (some of these items are a little more involved and you may choose to have a technician to perform);
- 1. Inspection of the brake system (technician).
- NEV-R-LUBE visual inspection of the wheel bearings (technician).
- 3. Windows and door seals clean and coat with silicone after cleaning.
- 4. Wax the exterior of your trailer.

This list is by no means intended to be all-inclusive. You may or may not want to attempt any of these items yourself. Just something to think about and perhaps you will decide to perform some of the tasks yourself. Every little bit that you can do helps and it also makes the financial burden on your wallet a little less. I hope you find this nuts and bolts article helpful.

Please, if there is a topic you want me to research, just let me know. I need some ideas for the March newsletter. This joint rally was discontinued somewhere around 2010, with the last gathering having had 50 rigs present, including me. It was fantastic!



Here we go again, but let's set our sights higher and attract a hundred plus rigs this time around with this joint rally amongst the now 4 local Airstream Clubs in NC and SC: Carolinas Airstream Club; Palmetto State Airstream Club: Piedmont North Carolina Airstream Club: South Carolina Coastal Airstream Club.

Come join us in September 2023 for a first "guad club" rally in many years at the Palmetto Cove RV Park!



Carolinas Airstream Club is so excited about hosting a joint "NC/SC State Rally" at Palmetto Cove RV Park in September 2023! This park is nestled at the edge of the Blue Ridge Escarpment, just two miles off the Foothills Scenic Highway. Palmetto Cove RV Park was previously home to the annual Alumalina Rally and was originally founded as an Airstream campground designed for rallies.

A few years ago, before my wife Jan and I knew anything about Airstreams or the WBCCI, we saw an invitation in the Greenville News to an open house at Palmetto Cove Campground, where we could view the iconic campers and meet their owners.

We met Pam DeVine and toured her 16 foot Bambi named Sweet Pea. She was a wealth of information about both the club and the brand. We went on to meet many other Airstreamers and admired their rigs before we left the campground. Needless to say we were bitten by the bug! So we started looking for our first Airstream.

We found a 1976 Airstream Argosy in our price range and it looked great! So we bought it, and towed it home from Hartwell, Ga. I was impressed at how well it towed and we were excited to go camping in it soon. Our three grandsons slept in it soon after we brought it home and they were excited too. Things looked great! ## **Slow Cooker Breakfast Casserole**

## Ingredients:

26 oz. hash browns, thawed
16 oz. breakfast sausage
12 eggs
1 cup milk
2 cups cheese, grated
1 green bell pepper, chopped
1 green onion, chopped(for garnish)
cooking spray



## Directions:

Start by spraying your slow cooker with nonstick oil. Or you can use slow cooker liners, which completely eliminate any cleanup mess.

Place the thawed hash brown potatoes at the bottom of the slow cooker. Cook and drain your breakfast sausage and layer it on top of the potatoes. Place the chopped green pepper and cheese on top next.

Finally, whisk together all dozen eggs with one cup of milk and salt and pepper to taste. Pour the egg mixture over everything. Place the lid on your slow cooker, and cook on low for 8 hours. When the casserole is finished cooking, turn slow cooker to "warm" mode and keep it warm for a number of hours. I like to serve mine with extra shredded cheese, chopped green onions and hot sauce!
