Registrations now at **879**, have increased by **23** from last month's 856. We are expecting several drive-in registrations to help close the gap for a minimum of 1,200 Airstreams On-Site.

New 30-Amp electric \$255 deposits will place you on the 30-Amp Standby List. Ones on the Standby List will be notified should a 30-Amp Electric spot become available. If a spot does not open, your 30-Amp Electric deposit will be fully refunded.

The 3-Amp service provides only enough power to keep your batteries charged. It will not support a coffee pot, refrigerator, or other appliances.

Arrival Turn Photos into the 2009 Madison Rally Site BADGER DEN



Most Members will be traveling Interstate I-90 & I-39 and taking the Madison Exit #142A onto Hwy 12/18 West. Then in 5.9 miles, take Exit #261 North on to Park St/Hwy 151 This off ramp is shown in the extreme lower right corner of this photo.



After exiting above you make a right at the bottom of the off ramp. Then just a few car lengths you turn right again onto Badger Road, which is the next traffic light.



Traveling on Badger Road for 0.9 mile you will turn left at this Rusk Gate entrance into the Badger Den of the Alliant Energy Center.



Upon turning left into the Alliant Energy Ctr. you will be greeted by 3 Entry Booths and the Entry Verification and Greeter Members. They will then direct you to a specific line from where Parkers will pick you up and take you to your Rally Parking Site.

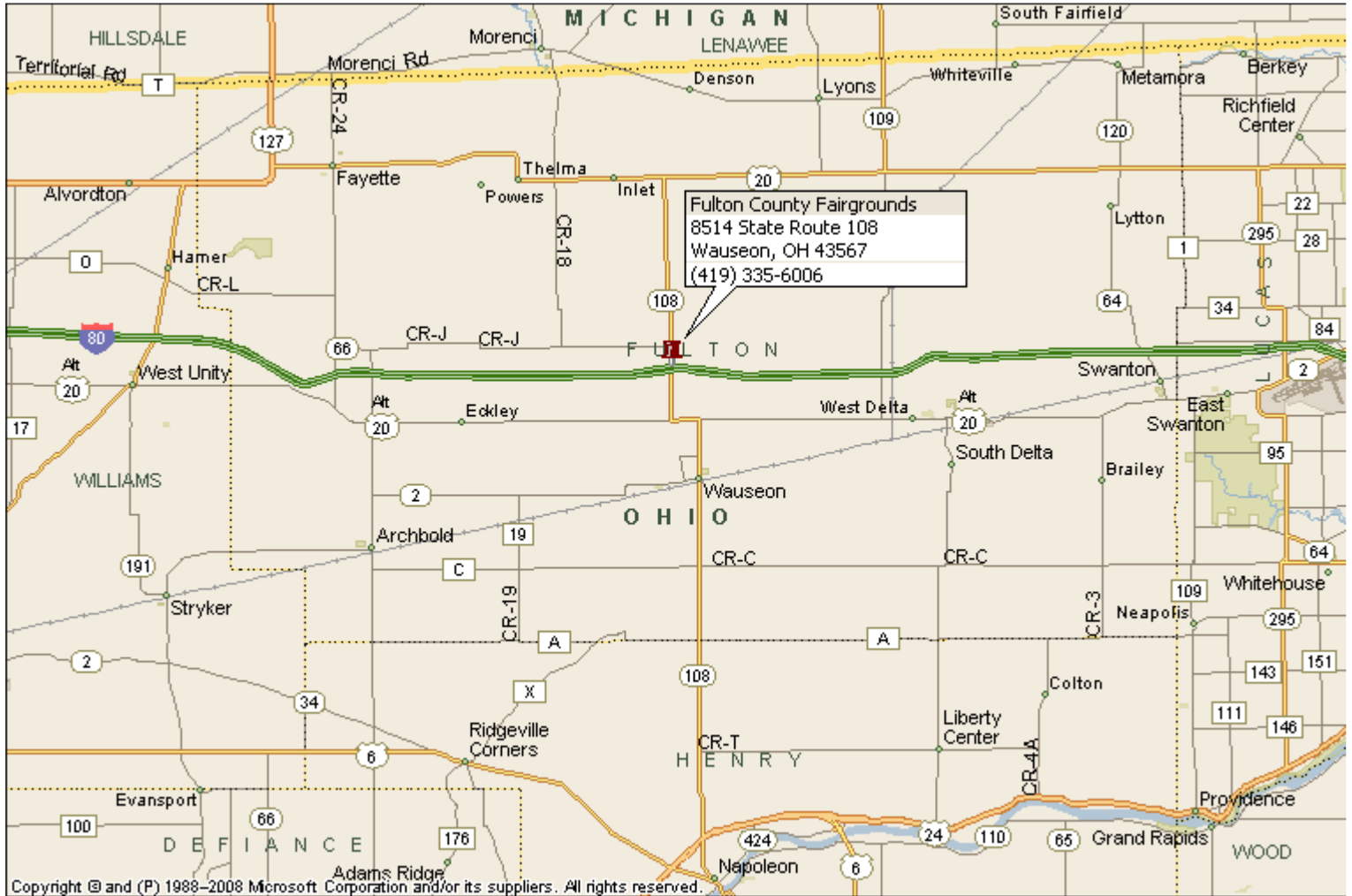

Through the courtesy of Airstream, Inc., all members pre-registering on or before January 1, 2009, will be eligible to participate in a drawing with up to \$5,000.00 in awards. The award may be redeemed at any Airstream Dealership or at the Jackson Center Service Facility for parts and service.

Rally Fees received after January 1, 2009, will be \$125.00 per Adult and \$45.00 for Parking an Airstream.

PARKING SERVICES Includes Rally Water, 3-Amp Electric (or 30 Amps, if purchased below), Holding Tank pump outs about every 3-4 Days, & Dump Station.

PARKING POLICY You must select only one (1) Parking Area below. The running of Generators is permitted only with exhaust extensions that DO NOT expel exhaust gasses into another RV. The parking area for the running of Generators may be located in a remote area. Handicap (Wheelchair or Cane Only) must have an application on file at Headquarters or enclose a Handicap Application. In the event that there are less than 12 Applications for any one area, those requests may be combined with another area. ALL RV spaces MUST be filled resulting in different areas being in the next row or beside you.

FREE Parking in the Badger Den is available with no services and is permitted for one (1) night on, or the day before, your parking date. Additional nights in the Badger Den and early arrivals on site will be charged at the rate of \$20.00/night with a minimum of \$100.00 if a Rally Fee and Airstream Parking Fee is not paid.

ALL arrivals will enter the Rally Site through the Rally Verification Committee in the Badger Den. Once cleared, you will be parked between 8:00 AM and 4:00 PM, Monday through Saturday. On Sunday, there is ONLY self parking in the Badger Den.

The Parking, Water, and Electric Crews will do their best to park and connect you to water and electric on the day you arrive. But, it could be the next day, (excluding Sundays) depending on your arrival time and the number of arrivals on that day. So make sure your batteries are fully charged, water tank is full, and holding tanks are empty before you arrive.

REFUND POLICY All refund requests must be written, postmarked by May 1, 2009, and must include the complete pass receipt. All cancellations will be assessed a \$25.00 administrative fee. Refund requests after May 1, 2009, will be at the discretion of the International Rally Committee. 30-Amp Electric Service must be obtained by April 1, 2009, is NOT TRANSFERABLE, with NO refunds if postmarked after April 1, 2009.

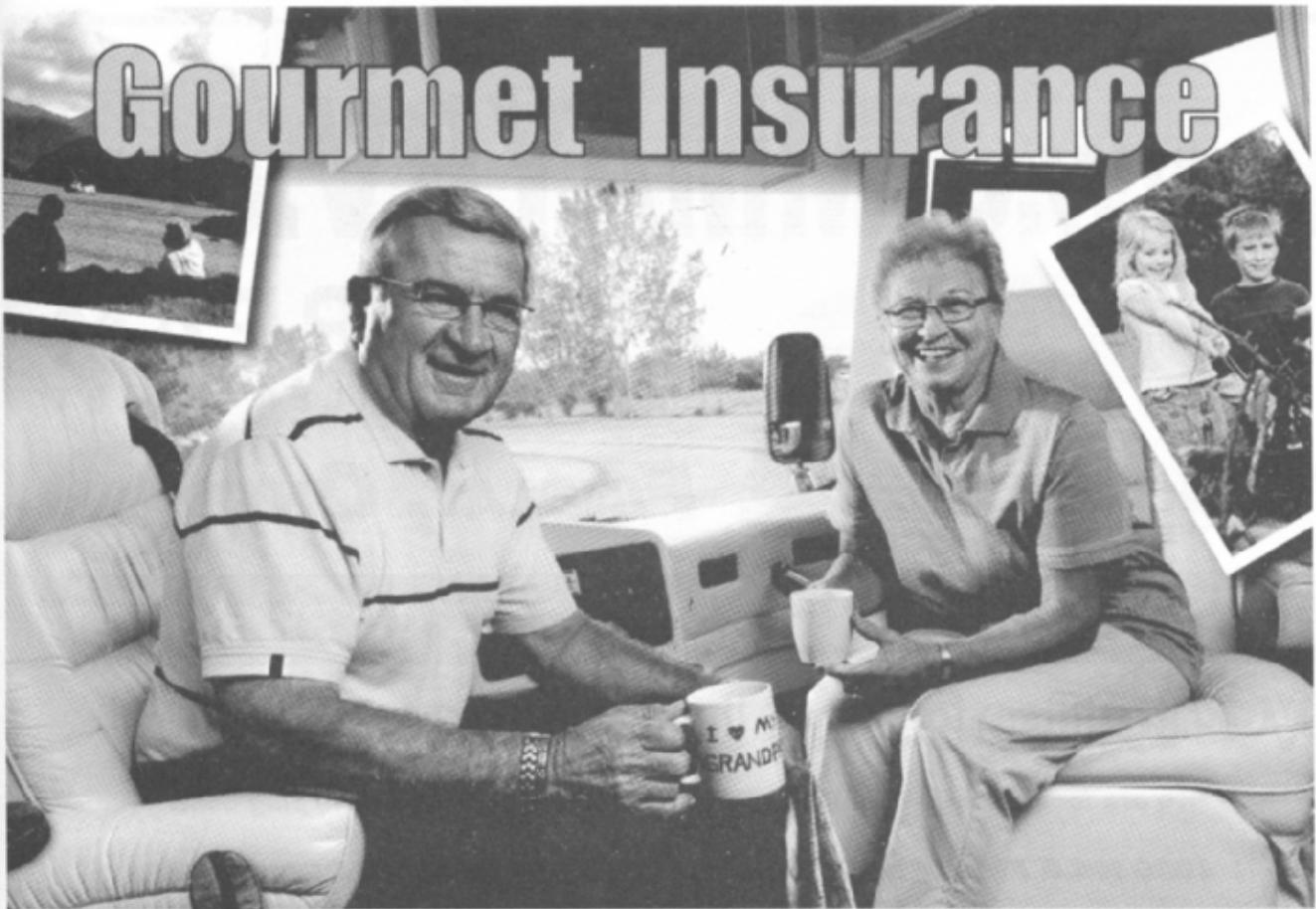

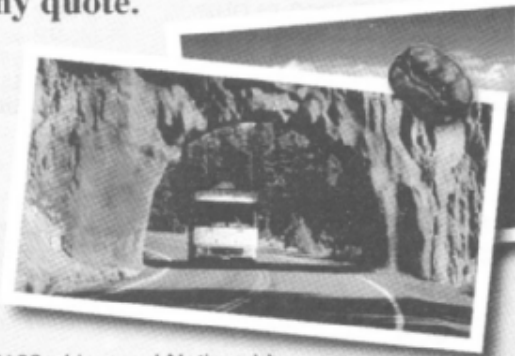
