President's Corner

Hello everyone.

The IBT is history and there were a few votes that affect us all. I'm not going to have a comment on all of the results, but I will have a comment on issues I feel everyone will be interested in. If any one has a specific question e-mail it to me and I will answer it to the best of my ability. We had 29 motions to consider and not a lot of time to spend on each issue, but there were some exceptions.

(1) Unit name change passed (2) The transfer of funds was misunderstood by quite a few members. This was a ves vote so the WBCCI could get their money back from the International Rally Fund. (3) No! The unit and Region that puts on the rally should get any money that is above and beyond the expense. (4) Yes! The more info we get the better.

(5) Referred back to maker. (6) Yes (7) Yes! We needed this so we could implement a change that was passed in June. (8) Yes! (9) Yes! (10) Yes! Region 4 does not get paid mileage to attend their own rallies now. This puts all regions on a level playing field. (11) Yes! Corrects previous error (12) Yes! This reduces International travel funds by 25% or approximately \$10M. I would like to add that the International Officers are a long way from spending all of their budget this year. (13) Yes! Reduces region officer's travel by 10%. Would have been more but we are not sure what is going to be needed if we combine regions in the future. (14) Yes! Increase International dues from \$55 to \$65 a request for \$75 was amended to \$65. I did not want to increase dues but there was no way to balance the budget with out it. If we eliminate all International and Region travel budgets we would still have a deficit by 2012. By the June meeting I'm sure we will have ways to cut more. The 2020 committee is working on motion 26 now. I will keep you posted on this one. If you have any suggestions e-mail me. (PS) I do not do the forums so post what you want, but I will never see it. (15) No! Would have changed the way units tallied votes. (16) Withdrawn (17) Yes! We need marketing to go forward with some plans to get new members and more ads for the Blue Beret. (18) Yes! This motion combined all of the grievance motions into one. We have had 58 grievances this year. Come on enough is enough lets get back to Fun and Adventure. (26) Yes! This was passed on to the 2020 committee. If some or all of this passes it would save up to \$80M a year. It would combine regions, combine Region and International rallies; eliminate some international officers and more. We are going to down size. I hope all the members of Region 4 will give me feed back on what you like and dislike about any new issues that come up. I sent out an e-mail asking the members what they thought about the \$20 increase in dues and received responses from 4 units. It's our club let's get involved and let me know what your thoughts are. Motion (27) (28) (29) were withdrawn. It must be Happy Hour some where.

We will talk more about this at the Region 4 business Rally in Wauseon. It will be open to all members. Hope to see you then.

If you see any that you would like to take from the box, you may. What is left will be donated to churches or any organization that can use it. If your children or grand-children have moved on to more mature reading please consider contributing the books for organizations in Gillette. 
If You Build It . . .

Region 4 Airstreamers Rick & Elaine Richardson have suggested Region 4 become involved in a Habitat for Humanity build.


Habitat is scheduling building projects known as Care-A-Vans specifically for RVers. Here are a few particulars:

Most RV Care-A-Vanner builds involve eight to 20 volunteers and last two weeks, with 10 six- to seven-hour workdays. A typical day begins with devotions and includes morning, lunch and afternoon breaks. Volunteers bring their own hand tools—tool belt, hammer, square, pencil, measuring tape—and the affiliate provides everything else including power tools, ladders, building materials, instruction and supervision.

Care-A-Vanners are on teams. Team members pay their own expenses, which may be tax deductible, and the host affiliate arranges for RV parking—usually free or at a nominal charge. Teams can expect at least minimal electric hookups, access to water and a dump station nearby. Hosting affiliates also may provide lunches and a welcome gathering. Due to safety and hygiene issues, pets are not permitted on the work site.



There is a build scheduled for June 13-25 in Sheridan Wyoming that is filling up fast. Sheridan is less than 100 miles from the International in Gillette that starts on June 27^{th} – here is a chance to add two weeks to your International visit to Wyoming and get free parking! Did You Know . . .

Wauseon is the home of the Fulton County Historical Museum?

The museum has undertaken a 5 year project titled "Hell & Homefront: Civil War Through Fulton County Eyes"



The museum has an extensive collection of Civil War artifacts, but will not focus on a glorification of war or battles. They instead intend to collect information on the viewpoints of Fulton County residents both on the battlefield and at the home front. Their findings will be reported in a series of presentations this spring at the three area libraries. More information is available at www.fultoncountyhs.org

Wauseon was named after a Potawatomi chief. The Potawatomi were part of the Algonquian Family located in the upper Mississippi region.

The Sauder Woodworking Company in nearby Archbold operates a co-gen plant that burns sawdust to create electricity. The plant burns as much as 145 tons of



sawdust daily. In addition to Sauder there are also other furniture manufacturers such as Archbold Furniture Company that specializes in unfinished furniture made of real wood.


