

That work also led Andy to create a system for estimating repairs right down to the number of rivets required.

#### From the WBCCI Forums


The Forum Folks continue to improve the WBCCI Airstream Forum. Here are a few samples from the busy rallies section on the forum.






#### Which Unit Should I Join?



- Indians & Soldiers



Convention/Rally Fees for registrations received prior to January 1, 2010, will be \$480 for couples, \$380 for singles, and \$120 for each additional adult. Convention/Rally fees for the first 1000 to register include 30 amp electricity, water, and sewer (No 3 amp electricity or generator section available).

Rally Fees received after January 1, 2010, will be \$500.00 for couples, \$390 for singles, and \$130 for additional adults.

Through the courtesy of Airstream, Inc., all members pre-registering on or before January 1, 2010, will be eligible to participate in a drawing for **up to** a total of **\$2,000.00** in awards. 


