Sedalia

Sedalia, Missouri, site of the 2012 International Rally, is located approximately in the middle of the state. Founded by General George Rappeen Smith in 1857, Sedalia was at one time the western most part of the Missouri Pacific Railway. This led to Sedalia to become one of the first cowtowns, supplying cattle to Eastern cities such as Chicago.

Sedalia also lays claim to helping in the birth of Ragtime music. Composer and publisher Scott Joplin worked in Sedalia as a pianist, attended George R. Smith College, and published his first rags before moving on to St. Louis.

Today Sedalia has a population of about 20,000 and features a number of attractions:

- The Katy Depot. Originally part of the Missouri-Kansas-Texas Railroad. The name Katy comes from the companies K-T abbreviation on the stock exchange.
- Katy Trail State Park. The nations longest Rails to Trails project. Bring you bicycles for trails that cover most of the state and feature a five day journey for those up to the ride!



• The Scott Joplin International Ragtime Foundation maintains the Ragtime Store located in the Bothwell Hotel. The Bothwell is also a historic site and is listed on the National Register of Historic Places.





• The Daum Museum of Contemporary Art. The core of the permanent collection at the Daum is comprised of abstract paintings, drawings, prints, works in clay and sculpture created since the mid-20th century.



• The Missouri State Fair. Held in Sedalia each August since 1901. Site of the WBCCI International Rally in 2012.

Convention/Rally Fees for registrations received prior to **January 1, 2012** will be \$475.00 for couples, \$375.00 for singles, and \$120.00 for each additional adult. Rally fees include **3 point hook-up**, 30 amp electric, water and sewer. (Note: *NO 3 amp. electric or generator section available*).

Rally Fees received after January 1, 2012 will be \$500.00 for couples, \$400.00 for singles and \$130.00 for each additional adult. Through the courtesy of Airstream, Inc, all members pre-registering on or before January 1, 2012 will be eligible to participate in a drawing for up to a total of **\$2000.00** in awards, These awards may be redeemed at any Airstream Dealership or at the Jackson Center Service Center for parts and service.

Free parking in the Bull Pen, with no services, is permitted for one night before your assigned parking date only. For arrival before your parking date and parking with services, the parking fee is \$20.00 per day.

FEE REFUND POLICY: All convention/rally fee refund requests must be postmarked by **May 15, 2012** and must include the complete pass receipt, and FREE picnic tickets if applicable. All cancellations will be assessed a \$30.00 administrative fee and price of FREE picnic tickets if not returned. There will be **NO** refunds if postmarked after May 15, 2012 except as approved by the International Rally Committee.

The rally fee will only be \$195.00 for two in an airstream trailer/motorhome (\$125.00 for singles). Rally fee includes, 3 full catered breakfasts, 3 full catered dinners (one of which is a \$100 dinner cruise on the Goodtime II), parking for 4 nights, daily & evening entertainment, and a rally goodie bag!
