Greetings from Florida. I hope everybody is keeping warm. We are having unusually warm temperatures here in Florida. I just got the International Membership Chairman's Report for January and want to share a few items included in his report.

- 1) As of December 2011, we had 5323 members which unfortunately is 273 less than the same period in 2010 or a loss of 4.9%. The good news is that this percentage (of loss) is a lot lower than in 2009.
- 2) Region 4 as of December 23, 2011 had 460 members. We had 30 new members in 2011. Of the 15 units that make up Region 4, 11 units had some new members.
- 3) In January Cindy Reed mailed a letter to each member that did not renew with a survey of why they did not renew. She also sent an e-mail to those members that had e-mail addresses which also contained the survey. The results of the survey will be available in the spring.

- 4) Each month I get a report of new members and new owners of Airstreams. If there is a MAL or a new owner in Ohio, I e-mail that information to the proper membership chairman. I hope you are contacting the respective member in those reports.


