PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE



By the time you read this we will have already had the February Valentine Rally at Hardy's Resort in Bryan, TX held February 9-12th. We had a wonderful turnout of 16 rigs. Although the weather started out cool and windy, we got our trailers set up and a number of rigs had their flags waving briskly in the wind! Unfortunately, Jerry and Irene Lyddon had to cancel at the last minute due to her having emergency hip replacement surgery on her left hip. A day later, she

had to go back to the hospital as the new hip came out of the socket. Back to the hospital and after getting a brace to hold everything in place, she is recovering at home. Keep Irene in your thoughts and maybe send her a Get-Well card. We missed seeing you both.

Several of our club members visited the George H.W. Bush Presidential Library on the Campus of Texas A & M University. This was our first time to see it and we came away totally impressed with not only the Library itself, but with a greater appreciation of President Bush's accomplishments as 20 year old WW2 war-hero Navy pilot, co-founder of the Zapata Offshore Drilling Company, U.S. House of Representative, Ambassador to the United Nations, U.S. liaison to China, Director of the C.I.A., Vice President of the U.S. under President Ronald Reagan, subsequently elected as the 41st President of the United States, Commander In Chief of military operations in Panama and the Persian Gulf, freed Kuwait and assembled 30 countries to defeat Iraq and signed both the Disabilities Act and Clean Air Act in 1990. Bush died at the age of 94 and is buried behind his Presidential Library along with wife Barbara and daughter Robin.

There have been few other Presidents who accomplished this much for our country and were true statesmen, father, and genuinely nice person as President Bush. When He was president, Maria and I had the pleasure of spending time in Kennebunkport, Maine with a Secret Service Agent on his security detail and seeing his summer residence there. The Agent told us first-hand how down to earth the

Bushes were and how well he treated his protectors. Years later after President Bush had retired to Houston, Maria of some of her friends were eating at a Houston restaurant when George and Barbra came in to eat. President Bush and wife greeted Maria's group and happily posed for photos with them! We could certainly use more Presidents with the qualities of President Bush. If you have not been to the Library and seen the 30 minute film on his life, you would do well to visit there!
