Wednesday (April 12)

- **1pm** - Earliest check-in time
- **3pm - 6pm** – Happy Hour at Altstadt Brewery, 6120 East, US-290. \$3 Draft pints, \$5 House wine, \$7 appetizers

Thursday (April 13)

- **1pm** - Earliest check-in time for new arrivals
- **5pm** – Happy Hour and appetizers near Kruer's site. Bring a chair, drinks and appetizer to share. We will discuss plans for the rally and meet new friends.

Friday (April 14)

- **9am - 5pm** – Fredericksburg Trade Days, **355 Sunday Farms Lane**. It is 3.9 miles from Arch Ray. Parking is \$5 and good for all weekend. There are over 350 vendors and a Biergarten. This is a good place to have lunch.
- **1pm** - Earliest check-in time for new arrivals
- **2pm** – Wine tasting at Wildseed Farm Winery is \$20 per person. You will pay at the winery on arrival. The address is **100 Legacy Drive** and is located across from the Trade Days. This is a working wildflower farm and sells hundreds of seeds and plants. After tasting explore the farm.
- **5pm-ish** - Happy hour. Bring a chair, and drinks. Location TBD.
- **6pm-ish** – Pitch-in dinner at campground. Please bring your meat, set-ups, drink and a side dish to share. We will have tables set up for the food.
- **Dusk**- Spontaneous campfires. Set up at your site for people to stop by.

- Do not attach leashes/chains/ropes to trees, landscaping, or our structures, pedestals, or faucets.
- Please have your current vaccination record with you.
