#### President's Message

The month of February has been somewhat disappointing. It started out OK but soon began to deteriorate. Several MAAC members indicated they would be attending the party on February 11 but as the day drew near, they began to cancel. By February 9 only one couple planned to join the Jacobs. It was consequently decided that the amount of work involved was not justified by the number of attendees. I want to thank Alex and Jonathan for their kind offer to host the party. As I reported in last month's newsletter, I contacted the American Legion in Crisfield, MD to schedule our annual "Crabby Rally" for September 22-23, 2023. I requested that we be assigned six camping spots, numbers 7 to 12, for our club members. I also reported that the American Legion had not yet approved our request but I expected them to do so soon. As it turns out, the American Legion has changed its reservation policy. In the past, we could reserve all the camping spots, and pay for them, at one time. In MAAC's case this system worked well.



However, another RV club reserved six spots without paying for them up front. That club promised their members would pay for the spots upon arrival. As it turned out, only two of the camping spots were used and the American Legion lost the income from the unused camping spots. In the meantime, they had denied the requests of other campers who wanted to use their campground.

As a result of the above situation, the Crisfield American Legion no longer takes group reservations. Each MAAC member who wants to attend our "Crabby Rally" on September 22- 23, 2023, will need to contact the Crisfield American Legion on their own and make their individual reservation. They will ask for your credit card number so they can charge you for the reservation. Last year the cost was \$40.00 per night. We are not sure if that rate still applies because we have not received confirmation of our request to reserve spot number 12. The website has their operating hours and phone numbers. Once you call, follow the instructions that are included in their answering message. We were advised last year that the Crisfield American Legion would insist that people using their campground had to be members of the American Legion. For that reason, my husband Wayne, became a member. We do not know if they will accept a reservation request from someone who is not a member of the American Legion. If they decline to take your reservation request, you can try telling them that one of their members, Wayne Berkebile, is coordinating the rally. They may then take you reservation.





- And as always having fun and renewing friendships






# INDIAN LAKE STATE PARK RESERVATION For Jackson Center Caravan
