## A Guide for New Airstreamer's Planning Ahead for the Next Camping Season

So you are new to camping, or maybe you have been an Airstreamer for a few years.

Perhaps you are not sure why you miss out on Airstream events, or you are frustrated with not being able to secure a campsite for your travels.

I know, from my experience, it took a year or two to figure out how to make reservations or to get a spot in a local or state campground. These days, with so many folks camping, it has become even harder to secure a site for the time that fits my schedule.

I wanted to take an opportunity to pass on what I think might be helpful, so you can get the most out of your Airstream in the coming season.

Most of us here in the Region One area, the Northeast and Canada, have put our rigs away for a long winter's rest. We are busy with friends and family from Thanksgiving to the New Year.

As we look out the window on cold January days and see the snow pile on the trailer, wishing we could be in a warmer climate enjoying that beautiful rig of ours - instead of dreaming of the trip you wish you were on, now is the perfect time to get a jump on how you can enjoy that rig in a few months.

There are many resources to help in planning and making memories with our Airstream friends and the friends we have not yet met. In October and November, all units in the International Airstream Club submit their schedules to be published in the Blue Beret, as well as on the <u>Airstream Club International event calendar</u> There is likely an Airstream event in just about any place across the country you might have on your travel plans. In addition, most clubs publish a newsletter that will have the events and rallies they are sponsoring during the upcoming year. The schedule for our club is in this month's Capers. If you want to see what other local clubs have planned for the year to come, consider becoming an Affiliate member so you can get their newsletters as well. They might offer events that fit your schedule.

Beyond club events, other resources to consider are national/state park campgrounds and KOA camping. Booking national and state campgrounds can take some planning due to booking rules particular to each facility. <u>ReserveAmerica</u> and <u>Recreation.gov</u> are popular sites for making your reservations. Be prepared to book sites 4, 6 and even 12 months in advance. <u>KOA Campgrounds</u> are generally good bets for the most popular locations across the country and becoming a KOA member offers discounted prices on your bookings.

I hope this helps you get most of what the club has to offer and that your upcoming season plans come together so you can get the most use of your Airstream. I will make regular contributions to the Capers with places and campgrounds you might like to add to your "Places to Visit" list. RALLY FEES – \$435 for an RV On-Site with 30 amp electric, water, and pump-outs; \$130 for each Adult (18+); \$40 for each Youth 13-17; Free for Children (12 & Under).

ADA ACCESSIBLE PARKING – Special parking, if requested, is near the central rally area for members. We ask that you bring your government/state-issued placard or supporting documentation with you to the rally.

REGISTRATIONS – Through the courtesy of Airstream, Inc., members registered before the start of the rally are entered into a prize drawing. Over \$2,000 in gift certificates for parts and service will be given away. Registrants must be present at the Airstream presentation to win.

STAGING AREA – In an attempt to keep the rigs moving, you will receive a rally arrival date in the Spring of 2022. If you can't make it on that date, the Rally Arrival Team will be ready to park you when you arrive from 8:00 am to 8:00 pm. Arrivals after 8:00 pm may stay overnight in the Staging Area, with no hookups, until parking begins the next morning.

CANCELLATION POLICY – Refund requests received by May 28<sup>th</sup>, 2022, will be assessed a \$50.00 fee. Refund requests after May 29<sup>th</sup>, 2022, will be assessed a 50% fee. NO refunds after July 9<sup>th</sup>, 2022. If you might have to cancel after that day, please consider obtaining travel insurance.

RALLY PARKING DATES – General parking is tentatively scheduled to begin around July 20<sup>th</sup>. Parking dates will be sent via email in Spring 2022. Caravans of 5 or more need to contact HQ at <u>rally@airstreamclub.org</u> for arrival date.


