Nuts & Bolts

Fresh Water Tank Care

Of the three tanks on our recreational vehicle, the one that requires the least amount of attention and upkeep is the one that is mostly ignored and that is the fresh water tank. This is not good because ignoring our fresh water tank care can endanger our health. If you travel much at all with your Airstream, you know that water quality can vary greatly from campground to campground. Unfortunately, not all campgrounds take good care of their water systems as they should. This is why it is so important to keep your onboard supply of water clean. With this in mind, use the following steps to clean and purify your RV water system.

- 1. Drain the tank completely
- 2. Remove and discard old water filter
- 3. Make a mixture of 1/4 cup of bleach with 1 gallon of water and add to tank (3 gallons of this mixture for a 50 gallon tank)
- 4. Fill the tank with clean water to include the 3 gallons of mixture
- 5. Do not use more than the prescribed ratio
- 6. Open each faucet, first cold and then hot until you smell chlorine
- 7. Make sure to turn faucets off
- 8. Allow system to stand for 4 hours
- 9. Drain the system
- 10. Refill fresh water tank and flush system
- 11. Install new water filter
- 12. Top off fresh water tank

You are now ready to hit the road for your next camping adventure. Your fresh water tank is clean and sanitized and full of clean water. Remember, it is not a bad idea to travel with your fresh water tank full, you never know when you will need it for a bathroom break, an unexpected need for a shower or power failure at the campground well system (no power, no water). This is not a bad thing to do before you start the camping season. For those of you who camp year round, when was the last time you sanitized your water system? Safe travels to everyone and see ya down the road.

Welcome to **Silver in the City,** a "Wake Up Downtown" Airstream Rally, hosted by members of the Palmetto State Airstream Club 22. We are very glad to have you join us for this "Sixth Annual" special and unique event. We will be parking on both sides of main street (Congress Street) in downtown York, SC, population 9,300.

This will be a *boondocking* rally, so please arrive with a full tank of fresh water and empty grey and black tanks.

<u>Quiet</u> generators are welcome. We will have a dump site for departure on Sunday morning. Our "Bull Pen" will be at 105 Garner Street. The City of York Police Department will assist us in parking. All parking on the main drag will be with doors opening to the center of the street. We will also have two large parking lots available for us to park in. Parking begins at 9:00am on Friday morning. We will need an accurate rig count, so please let us know if you are not coming, as soon as possible, and because we have people on the waiting list who would like to join this fun rally.

Our plan is to have everyone parallel parked to the curb and then backed up to each other. We will help you get parked. You will want to park as close to the curb without scuffing your tires. All parking downtown is within easy walking distance of everything. We also have those two parking lots available to those that do not want to park on the street.

The City Market will serve as our central gathering point where we can assemble as a group for any information sharing. We will have a kick off social planned meeting at the City Market at 5:00pm on Friday, but other than that, no organized meals or events are planned other than the **OPEN HOUSE** on Saturday afternoon and doughnuts and coffee Sunday morning. We urge you to patronize the local merchants and restaurants; they are always very excited that we are coming and have many specials to offer. Please be sure to wear your Club Badge so we can recognize you. We will also provide a rally packet with information on what to see and do in York.

We hope you will participate in the **OPEN HOUSE** on Saturday afternoon from 1:00pm – 4:00pm, the community will want to peek inside your Airstreams. Who knows maybe we'll get more people excited to be Airstreamers! The street will be closed for the entire weekend to facilitate foot traffic for this event!

Once again, the rally fee will be to donate to PATH, *"People Attempting To Help"*. PATH is a local, multi-church supported charity that reaches far into the York community. We are suggesting a \$10 or more donation, per person. Checks can be made out to **"PATH"**. Airstreamers make a difference! Please be generous, because this is a very worthy organization!

Once again, this year on Thursday night our pre-rally gathering/celebration will be held at York Place, 234 Kings Mountain Street, York. We will not have any utilities there but we will have plenty of parking on pavement, and we are only a few blocks from downtown. The entrance will be marked. Please join us there if you can, and we can have a supper together. From there we will parade into town with police escort on Friday morning. <u>Fly your flags!</u>

Come ready to embrace each other and the City of York, and have a great time knowing you are leading the way to another GREAT Airstream adventure! If you need anything at all, don't hesitate to reach out.

Abbreviated synopsis from Past Region 3 President, John Leake:

For many years all of the Airstream Clubs in the Carolinas came together to hold an annual rally called the "Carolinas State Rally." It was held at the Palmetto Cove RV Park and hosting rotated among the then 6 local Airstream Clubs. This joint rally was discontinued somewhere around 2010, with the last gathering having had 50 rigs present, including me. It was fantastic!



Here we go again, but let's set our sights higher and attract a hundred plus rigs this time around with this joint rally amongst the now 4 local Airstream Clubs in NC and SC: Carolinas Airstream Club; Palmetto State Airstream Club; Piedmont North Carolina Airstream Club; South Carolina Coastal Airstream Club.

Come join us in September 2023 for a first "guad club" rally in many years at the Palmetto Cove RV Park!



Carolinas Airstream Club is so excited about hosting a joint "NC/SC State Rally" at Palmetto Cove RV Park in September 2023! This park is nestled at the edge of the Blue Ridge Escarpment, just two miles off the Foothills Scenic Highway. Palmetto Cove RV Park was previously home to the annual Alumalina Rally and was originally founded as an Airstream campground designed for rallies.

This rally is a refresh and renewal of a historical joint rally amongst the local Airstream clubs in North Carolina and South Carolina.

Carolinas Airstream Club will be taking the lead hosting duties for the 2023 event, but we hope to continue this rally annually and rotate the hosting duties through all four local clubs. In addition to its beautiful views and accommodations, Palmetto Cove RV Park offers



plenty of nearby attractions and outdoor activities, including Table Rock Mountain, Caesar's Head State Park, Jones Gap State Park, Victoria Valley Vineyards, Table Rock Tea Company and Dupont Forest.

The park offers 148 full hookup sites (30 & 50 amps) with easy parking. Also, there is a lounge and dining hall for rally events.

Cowboy Caviar

Ingredients:

1 can black-eyed peas, drain & rinse

- 1 can black beans, drain & rinse
- 1 can corn, drain
- 3-4 fresh tomatoes
- 1 red or orange bell pepper (or ½ of each)
- 2 jalapeños, remove seeds
- ¹/₂ of a red onion
- 1 avocado, dice in large chunks
- (if you chop too small it disappears into the mixture)

A handful of cilantro, chopped but not too fine (you want to be able to see it!)

Dressing:

Juice of one lime 1 tsp chili powder 1 tsp cumin 1 tsp salt 1 Tbsp honey or maple syrup ¼ cup of olive oil If you want it tangier, add some white wine vinegar.

Directions:

Dice all your vegetable ingredients. Add everything into a big bowl. Make the dressing and pour over the top of all ingredients and mix well. Serve with taco chips. Enjoy!
