Apple & Pear Crisp

Ingredients

Filling:

- 2 Honeycrisp Apples peeled, cored and sliced thin
- 2 Bartlett Pears peeled, cored and sliced thin
- ¹/₄ cup raisins
- 1/4 cup craisins
- 1 tbsp all-purpose flour
- 2 tbsp honey
- 1¹/₂ tbsp lemon juice

¹/₄ cup sliced almonds

Topping

½ cup all-purpose flour
½ cup packed brown sugar
½ cup quick cooking oats
½ cup butter

Directions

Preheat the oven to 375°F. Lightly grease an 8 inch baking dish.

Mix the fruit filling ingredients in the greased baking dish. Top with the sliced almonds.

In a bowl, mix the topping ingredients to the consistency of coarse crumbs. Sprinkle loosely over the fruit mixture.

Bake 45 minutes in the preheated oven, or until brown and crisp on top.

Tye's Tip:

Clean the surface with original WD40 (not the silicone spray) then wash off the WD40 with a solution Dawn dish liquid
