



A Guide for New Airstreamers (and Maybe a Few Old): Rhode Island

Camping season is now in full swing and many of our Clubs have rallies planned for the month of May. In the last issue of the Caper I listed some of the Region 1 events and hope people have signed up to attend. I will be enjoying the beautiful state of Rhode Island in the next few weeks. The rallies happen to be in two of my favorite camparounds.

First, this coming weekend I will be with my friends from the New England Club at Fisherman's Memorial CG with hosts Bonnie Hogan and Greg Desnoyers. Fisherman's is State of Rhode Island Park in Narragansett, this park offers three areas for RV's and one area for tent camping. The sites are large and for the most part in Area 1 and 4 they are level. Area two has some level



sites, but there are many that are on inclines. Sites can be reserved a year ahead, with Area 1 the most desirable full hook up sites. Area 2 also has full hook up site as well and Area 4 has electric and water on site which offer grassy sites and privacy, if that is what you desire. Areas 2, 3 and 4 have new shower house/bathrooms. Planning is a must for this campground in the Point Judith area, where Block Island is ferry ride away.

There are a number of nice restaurants in the area, Aunt Carrie's has a key lime pie to die for, Iggy's offers classic Rhode Island clam cakes and chowder. George's of Galilee offer a number of seafood dish in a nice location for afternoon out. Arturo Joes Grill & Bar offers Italian, the food is very good and you will find it to have a nice atmosphere.



If history is your interest, the Gilbert Stuart Museum is a short drive from the campground in North Kingston, you might not recognize the name, but I am sure you have seen at least one of his famous paintings. You might have seen a portrait of George Washington in a classroom. You will find the grounds of the museum has beautiful gardens and water ways with a working grinding wheel and water wheel driven looms. This is a wonderful historic site to visit on a sunny day.

The name Fishermen's Memorial was chosen to honor all Narragansettarea fishermen, both commercial and sport. In 1970, the former fort opened as a campground. A former military fire control tower serves as

park headquarters. An Army Reserve facility still occupies part of the site.



RALLY FEES – \$435 for an RV On-Site with 30 amp electric, water, and pump-outs; \$130 for each Adult (18+); \$40 for each Youth 13-17; Free for Children (12 & Under).

ADA ACCESSIBLE PARKING – Special parking, if requested, is near the central rally area for members. We ask that you bring your government/state-issued placard or supporting documentation with you to the rally.

REGISTRATIONS – Through the courtesy of Airstream, Inc., members registered before the start of the rally are entered into a prize drawing. Over \$2,000 in gift certificates for parts and service will be given away. Registrants must be present at the Airstream presentation to win.

STAGING AREA – In an attempt to keep the rigs moving, you will receive a rally arrival date in the Spring of 2022. If you can't make it on that date, the Rally Arrival Team will be ready to park you when you arrive from 8:00 am to 8:00 pm. Arrivals after 8:00 pm may stay overnight in the Staging Area, with no hookups, until parking begins the next morning.

CANCELLATION POLICY – Refund requests received by May 28th, 2022, will be assessed a \$50.00 fee. Refund requests after May 29th, 2022, will be assessed a 50% fee. NO refunds after July 9th, 2022. If you might have to cancel after that day, please consider obtaining travel insurance.

RALLY PARKING DATES – General parking is tentatively scheduled to begin around July 20th. Parking dates will be sent via email in Spring 2022. Caravans of 5 or more need to contact HQ at rally@airstreamclub.org for arrival date.
